Proposal for amendment in existing para 1.2(ii) and para 7 of the Ordinance 8(VIII) concerning the "Medical Attendance Rules".

A. PARA 1.2 of Jamia's Ordinance VIII to be replaced as under:

"1.2: These rules shall apply to the following category of employees:-

- (ii) Temporary, Casual Workers with Temporary Status, Reemployed and employees on contract basis **appointed on the sanctioned posts in the proper time scale of pay**;

- (iv) Employees on daily wages who have completed 240 days of service

NOTE:

- (1) Employees at S.No. (iii) and (iv) would be eligible for treatment facility at Ansari Health Centre and reimbursement of medical claim would not be allowed in any case.
- (2) Medical contribution will be paid by the employees at S. No.(i) and (ii) above as per the rates given in para 4 below".

(Existing para 1.2 (iv) of the Ordinance VIII, relating to Jamia retired employees has been deleted due to the fact that a separate Ordinance for the Jamia's retired employees has already been approved by the E.C. vide its meeting held on 12.9.2006. Besides, the existing para 1.2 (v) of the said Ordinance has been deleted owing to the fact that employees working in various hostels and kitchens fall within the categories as given at S. No. (i) to (iv) above).

- 7.8 "Since it is not always possible to obtain prior permission in any emergency involving accidents, serious nature of disease etc., the treatment taken by the employee in an emergency (duly certified by the concerned hospital where such treatment has been taken, will be considered on merits even if the treatment is taken from a private hospital which is not included in appropriate list of Jamia, and the reimbursement to be restricted to the approved CGHS rates. For granting permission ex-post facto approval in emergency cases, the power is delegated to the Vice-Chancellor.

It was also resolved that the following para would be incorporated suitably in the Prospectus of the University:

"Ragging in any form is prohibited in the University and those indulging in act(s) of ragging shall be punished."

Besides, the Majlis (AC) also approved the consequential amendment to be made in the relevant Ordinance, which shall read, as follows:

"Ordinance 14(XIV) STUDENTS DISCIPLINE

Decision on the proposal of framing an Ordinance on the "Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH)".

The Majlis (AC) noted that the Executive Council in its meeting held on 12.09.2006 (vide Reso. No. 3.3) had approved the Ordinance, concerning "Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH)" subject to the condition that formatting of the said Ordinance would be made by the Ordinance Committee of the University.

Pursuant to the above said EC's Resolution, the Majlis (AC) resolved to approve the revised Ordinance as recommended by the Ordinance Committee vide its meeting held on 13.9.2007 on "Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH)" and duly vetted by the Legal Advisor (**Annexure-XII**). This shall supersede the earlier provisions of the Ordinance 17(XVII) Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees at Work Place" and shall replace the said Ordinance.

Ordinance. The Majlis (AC) also noted that Ms. Nidhi's case could not be examined properly by the Department's Board of Studies as well as other concerned offices at the time of her registration in the Ph.D. programme. The Committee also noted the clarifications regarding the equivalence of BDS degree as received from the Association of Indian Universities vide its letter dated 16.11.2007, according to which the BDS/MBBS are graduate degrees where as for pursuing the Ph. D. degree a candidate must have passed the master degree course.

The Majlis after detailed deliberation resolved to permit the thesis of Ms. Nidhi Adaya, Research Scholar, D/o Applied Sciences & Humanities for evaluation as per the Jamia's procedure as a one time exception with the direction that this must not be a precedent in the future.

The Majlis (AC), while viewing the matter as serious lapse on the part of the authority responsible for admission to Ph.D. programmes, resolved that in future the post-graduation in any discipline shall make eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme. This needs to be taken care of by the Committee constituted for reviewing Ordinance relating to Ph.D. programme.
