### Approval of the proposal for allowing students with disabilities to use Computers in Examinations in case they cannot write with their hands.

The Majlis (AC) considered and approved the proposal made by the University Grants Commission vide its letter No. 6-8/2010(SCT/PWD) dated 27.1.2011 regarding use of computers by Persons with Disabilities for writing Examination in case they cannot write with their hands as requested by Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, New Delhi, vide their letter No. 13-1(Education Policy)/CCD/2010/324 dated 3.8.2010 along with the amendment by incorporating Para 6(1) (c) in Ordinance 15, as under:

"(C) Candidates who are suffering with writing disabilities and cannot write with their own hands would be entitled to seek assistance of computers for purpose of typing only subject to the condition that the computers/laptops shall be provided by the University on advance intimation of at least two weeks by the concerned candidate.

Provided further that the University shall ensure that the computer provided to the candidate does not have any data stored in it which is relevant to the examination in which the candidate is appearing, and that it does not have Internet facility. Such benefits to the physically challenged persons shall be allowed on production of a medical certificate from the designated authority.

### Proposal for amendment in Para 6.2 Ordinance 15-A concerning the University Examinations in Postgraduate Program under Creditbased Semester System.

The matter was deferred with the direction to place it in the next meeting of the Academic Council with a comprehensive proposal for amendment in the Ordinance 15-A of the University.

# Approval of the proposal for amendments in the Ordinance for making a provision of rotation of Headship, upto the Associate Professors.

The Majlis (AC) considered and approved the proposal made by Jamia Teachers' Association (JTA) for making provision of a rotation of Headship upto the Associate Professors of their respective Departments

of the University along with the amendment in the Ordinance 4 (IV) (Academic) as under:

"Provided further that in case of Departments, which have only one Professor who has already exhausted the Headship, the next senior-most Reader/Associate Professor shall be appointed as the Head of the Department.

Provided further that while giving weightage to seniority of the Associate Professors for the purpose of appointment as Head of the Department, due consideration is to be given for academic contribution as reflected by research output and publications as well as administrative capabilities and acumen.

It is further clarified that in case, as and when, the Department has two Professors, the said Reader/Associate Professor who has been nominated as the Head by virtue of the para hereinabove, shall cease to act as the Head, and the next Professor shall then be appointed as the Head of the Department."

### <u>Approval of the proposal for making provision of elected</u> <u>representation of various Centres on the Academic Council.</u>

The Majlis (AC) considered and approved the proposal made by Jamia Teachers' Association (JTA) to make a provision of elected representation of various Centres on the Academic Council to ensure all-round representation in the highest decision making body of the University along with the amendment to be made in the Statute 15(x-a) of JMI Act, 1988 as under:

"(x-b) Two teachers from the Centres created under Statute 22-A of the Jamia Millia Islamia Act, elected by teachers of such Centres for a period of three years. Provided further that no teacher shall be eligible for election to the Council for more than two terms during his/her entire tenure of service of the University."

### Approval of the proposed correction in the formula for SGPA in Para 5.4 of Ordinance of Ordinance 15-A (University Examinations in Postgraduate Programmes under Credit-based Semester System.

The Majlis (AC) considered and approved the proposed correction in the formula for calculating Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) as some typing error has been detected (**Annexure-VII**).

### Approval of the proposal for the inclusion of desirable specialization for the post of Associate Professor Asstt. Professor for the Centre for North-East Studies in the MMAJ Academy of Third World Studies.

The Majlis (AC) noted that two posts (one each of Associate Professor and Assistant Professor) were approved during the XI Plan allocation for the Centre for North-East Studies and the same was advertised vide Advertised No. 08/2010-11 dated 8.10.2010. During the process of screening of applications of these posts, one of the members of the Screening Committee objected that the desirable specialization should have been added along with the essential qualification. The desirable qualification proposed for these posts are as under:

"In addition to the requisite qualifications and a theoretical grasp of issues, applicants are expected to have field knowledge and experience of the North Eastern region as the NE Centre will have a focus among others, also on the following sectors: research and documentation, ethnicity and identity formation, media, the independence movement, conflict and governance, economy and development, the Sixth Schedule, migration and refugees issues, the Look East Policy and relations with neighbors and SE Asia, energy and environment".

The Majlis (AC) considered and approved the above desirable qualifications as approved by the Vice-Chancellor, in anticipation of the approval of the Board of Management of MMAJ Academy of Third World Studies, JMI.

### <u>Approval of the revised Ordinance 26(XXVI) concerning the re-</u> employment of superannuated teachers.

Proposal for modified Ordinance No. XXVI (26) relating to reemployment of teachers was again deliberated in the meeting in the light of written observations received from Prof. Faizan Ahmad, Director, Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Basic Sciences (CIRBS). The observations made by him were not agreed to. Prof. Zubair Meenai, Head, Department of Social Work was advised to send his written observations/suggestions to examine the same on merit. The Majlis (AC) approved the modified draft in principle. Necessary change if any, shall be incorporated on receipt of suggestion(s) after due examinations, before seeking Executive Council's endorsement.
