M.Tech Programmes (old system)

The Majlis (AC) directed that the guidelines of the Rehabilitation Council of India concerning the minimum percentage of marks required for passing various courses in the B.Ed. (Special Education) Programme be incorporated in the existing Examination Rules.

The Majlis (AC) further directed that the Centre for Distance & Open Learning should formulate Examination Rules for Master's/P.G. Diploma/Bachelor's/Diploma/Certificate programmes under the Distance Learning Mode so that they may be incorporated in Ordinance 15-D.

The Majlis (AC) also approved that all M.Tech. programmes will be brought under Ordinance 15-A from the Academic Session 2012-13.

While approving the above Ordinances, the Majlis (AC) appreciated efforts made by Prof. Zahid H. Khan, Chairman, Standing Committee for Act, Statutes and Ordinances, for re-structuring the said Ordinance.

It was informed that rules in respect of Faculty of Dentistry were received after the distribution of Agenda Notes. The proposed amendment in the Examination Rules of the BDS course as per the recent guidelines of the Dental Council of India, as shown in **Annexure-VII**. The Majlis (AC) authorized the Vice-Chancellor to include the same in the minutes after examining the rules.

Age criteria for appointment of Chair-Professors.

The Majlis (AC) noted that as per existing University's Ordinance 29(XXIX) (A) (Academic), a Chair Professor may be continued till attaining the age of 70 years. However, it has been felt that in exceptional cases, some scholarly eminent distinguished Academics and Professionals, who have crossed the age 70 years, but academically they are still very active, can contribute immensely to the University in their areas of expertise and hence may be appointed as "Chair Professor".

In view of the above, the Majlis (AC) considered and approved the proposed amendment in Ordinance 29-A (XXIX-A) (Academics) as shown in **Annexure-VIII**.

After detailed deliberation, it was resolved to shift the MBA (Evening) course to the Centre for Management Studies after consultation with AICTE, if required, in order to ensure improvement in the quality of the Programme.

Before concluding the meeting, the Vice-Chancellor (Chairman) informed the Majlis (AC) about the research work of Prof. M. Sami, Director, Centre for Theoretical Physics that has been cited by one of the Nobel Laureates of the Noble Prize in Physics 2011. He also informed about that the land of 214 Bighas and 19 Biswas (Khasra No. 67/2, 68/3 & 68/4) notified earlier by the Lt. Governor of Delhi in favour of Jamia Millia Islamia is at final stage and will be handed over to Jamia shortly.
