AC-2017 (II): Reso.-3

Consideration on the recommendation of the Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor for revision in Ph.D. Ordinance based on UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016 published in the Gazette of India vide Notification No. 278 dated 05.07.2016.

The Majlis (AC), after detailed deliberations, considered the recommendation of the Committee for revision in Ph.D. Ordinance based on UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016 published in the Gazette of India vide Notification No. 278 dated 05.07.2016. However, it was decided to review the draft ordinance with the help of a Committee comprising the following:
