To create awareness, inculcate some basic skills and knowledge on Tourism and work as student volunteers, on behalf of the Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India, the Department of Tourism, Hotel, Hospitality and Heritage Studies invites application from interested students of your college/university to apply for this 21 day training programme. The details are as follows:

- Eligibility:** College going students, minimum age 18 years, maximum age 25 years.  
**Mandatory:** NOC/Sponsoring letter from the concerned college Principal/HOD, for joining this training programme.  
**Stipend:** Successful trainees will be paid Rs. 1000/- for the entire programme.  
**Selection:** Through a written examination of 1 hour duration  
**Application Fee:** Rs. 100/= in cash or DD in favour of Jamia Millia Islamia, payable at New Delhi  
**Last date of Application:** 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2012  
**Exam Date:** 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2012  
**Venue:** Department of Tourism, Hotel, Hospitality and Heritage Studies  
**Time:** 11:30 A.M.  
**Training commencing on:** 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2012

**WEIGHTAGE:** A candidate with acceptable foreign language proficiency (a degree or a recognized certificate course) shall be entitled to additional five marks. Further, a candidate who is pursuing a B.A. course, or possesses this degree, with History, Archaeology, Fine Arts, Geography, Tourism and Travel or Indian Culture as one of the subjects shall also be entitled to additional three marks. These additions shall be available separately but on the condition that such additions shall not take a candidate's marks beyond 50 (maximum marks for the test prescribed). That means if a candidate scores 46/50 and he/she is a B.A. or studying in B.A. and also knows a foreign language(s), his/her marks shall be taken as 50/50.

This training programme titled "Earn While You Learn" sensitizing Youth to Tourism is commencing from 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2012.

This training is a very prestigious on going programme of the Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India since 2007 for preparing trained manpower in the tourism sector. Various aspects related to Indian Society and Culture, Overview of Tourism, Travel and Hospitality Industry, managerial and Behavioural skills are covered in the training alongwith study tour for hands on practical exposure.
