Eligibility Criteria

Faculty members and students having or pursuing M.Phil and Ph.D in Social sciences and allied subjects are eligible for the course. Interested M. Phil, Ph. Selection Process:

The number of seats is 30. The candidates for this course will be selected by the scientific committee constituted by the Director. The selected candidates will be informed by 25th November, 2014 thorough JMI website and email.
