

Prof. Ahmad was awarded the National Mineral Award, 1994, by the Government of India and is a life member of the Mineralogical Society of India. He is also a fellow of the Indian Academy of Sciences and a J C Bose fellow, 2011.

He is an alumnus of Aligarh Muslim University and Jawahar Lal Nehru University and has been post-doctoral fellow at University of Leicester and Cambridge University.

He is an expert member on the board of several environmental and geological organisations, including the Science & Engineering Research Council, and has won several accolades for his research.
