## **Admission Guidelines 2016-17**

- 1. B.Voc. Medical Laboratory Sciences (MLS)
- 2. B.Voc. Medical Electrophysiology (MEP)

Applications are invited for admission to 3 year B.Voc. Medical Laboratory Sciences and B.Voc. Medical Electrophysiology (MEP) for the academic session 2016-17. The course has been approved by the University Grants Commission under Deen Dayal Upadhyay Kaushal Scheme in the Centre for Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi.

The Course aims at providing the graduates of higher education systems to have adequate knowledge and skills for employment and entrepreneurship and also to fulfill the emerging needs of the economy. The course aims to incorporate the requirements of Para-Medical sector in the country with specific job roles in its curriculum in an innovative and flexible manner. The B.Voc. in both course also provides an opportunity of *exiting* course after completing 1 year with a Diploma (having NSQF Level 5), after completing 2 years with an Advance Diploma (having NSQF Level 6) and after completing 3 years with Bachelor of Vocational Degree (having NSQF Level 7).

- <u>Eligibility</u>:- Students who have passed 10+2 level examination (or equivalent) without any background of vocational training. Such students must have secured at least overall 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the 10+2 (or equivalent) level.
- No. of seats: 50 seats (Including all reservation as per JMI rules).
- Fee: The total annual fee (for 2 semester) of the courses will be Rs.13,200/- (Thirteen thousand two hundred only).
- Admission Form: The admission form may be downloaded from the JMI website. The duly filled form alongwith a bank draft (or postal order ) of Rs.100 (non-refundable) in favour of "Jamia Millia Islamia" payable at New Delhi must be submitted either in person or by post in the office of the Hony. Director, DDU Kaushal Kendra, Centre for Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi 110025 latest by 15.07.2016 upto 5:00PM.
  - Self attested mark-sheets of Class 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> must be submitted alongwith the application. The list of the candidates admitted in the courses will be displayed on the J.M.I. website. The candidates are advised to visit the J.M.I. website regularly for the latest updates.
