Admission Guidelines 2016-17 Diploma in Refrigeration & Air- Conditioning

Applications are invited for admission to 1 year Diploma in Refrigeration & Air-Conditioning course, for the academic session 2016-17. The course has been approved by the University Grants Commission under DDU Kaushal Kendra (Community College Scheme) attached to University Polytechnic, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi 110025.

The course aims at providing skilled manpower and technical persons in the highly demanding field of Refrigeration & Air- Conditioning for employment and entrepreneurship and also to fulfill the emerging needs of the economy. The course shall incorporate the requirements of various industry partners and Sector Skill Councils (SSC) in Refrigeration & Air- Conditioning sector with specific job roles in its curriculum in an innovative and flexible manner. The Diploma in Refrigeration & Air- Conditioning course provides an opportunity to become skilled in this field after completing one year (Two Semester).

• The candidates belonging to the following category will be eligible for admission in Diploma in Refrigeration & Air- Conditioning:

Category-1: Students who already acquired NSQF certification Level 4 in a particular industry sector and have opted admission in the courses under C.C in same trade with job role for which he/she previously certified at school level.

Category-2: Students who have acquired NSQF certification Level 4 but may like to change their trade and may enter into C. C in a different industry sector.

Category-3: Students who have passed 10+2 examination (with Science Stream) with conventional schooling without any background of vocational training. Such students must have secured at least overall 50% marks at 10+2 (or equivalent) level.

- The admission will be purely on merit basis including by 25% weightage of interview.
- The total annual fee of the course will be Rs. 10,000/- chargeable in two installments of Rs. 5000/= each at the beginning of Semester I & II.
- The admission form may be downloaded from the J.M.I. website (www.jmi.ac.in). The duly filled form along with a bank draft (or postal order) of Rs. 400/- (in favour of "Jamia Millia Islamia" payable at New Delhi, must reach the office of the Nodal Officer, Community College Scheme, University Polytechnic, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi-110025 either in person or by post latest by 15th July, 2016 up to 4:00 P.M.
- Self attested mark-sheets of the qualifying (class 12 or equivalent) examination and of class 10th must be submitted along with the application."
- The list of shortlisted candidates for the interview will be displayed on website after 20 July, 2016. The candidates are advised to visit the J.M.I website regularly for the latest updates.
