Guidelines for Admission in Ph.D. programme in Ilmu Advia and Moalajat

1. Eligibility Criteria for Admission

A candidate seeking admission in Ph.D. Programme in Ilmu Advia or Moalajat must have obtained a Mahir-e-Tib (M.D.) degree in Ilmu Advia/Moalajat.

2. Admission Procedure

The candidate shall apply online for admission to Ph.D. Programme in Ilmu Advia or Moalajat. The online application form is available on Jamia's website: <http://www.jmi.ac.in>. The application fee of Rs. 1000/- shall be submitted online for entrance test. The list of candidates found eligible to appear for the Entrance Test shall be notified on the website of the university.

The candidates will have to submit an affidavit making a self-declaration for his/her availability and successful completion of the course as and when conducted by the concerned Department/Centre/Faculty. No further relaxation will be given in this respect.

Jamia Millia Islamia shall conduct entrance test for admission to the above programme followed by interview.

The place of work for each selected candidate for Ph.D. programme will be decided as per the topic selected by the candidate and availability of infrastructural facilities with enrollment in JMI.

The stipend for students enrolled in Ph.D. programme shall be paid by CCRUM as per their norms.

*** Marked fee will be charged only in the first year. Tuition fee and Lab. Fee will be charged in all the subsequent years of the programme.**

3. **Entrance Test:** The Entrance Test will be held for short-listing of the applicants. Qualifying the Entrance Test will in no way entitle the candidate to any right to admission in the Ph.D. Programme in IlmuAdvia or Moalajat.

The medium of Entrance Test shall be English/Urdu.

The entrance test for Ph.D. programme in IlmuAdvia and Moalajat will be comprised of part 'A' and 'B', which shall be of three hours duration.

The Part 'A' of the question paper shall include 50 multiple choice (objective type) questions of one mark each on research aptitude & methodology, reasoning, comprehension, language, writing and analytical skills and contemporary issues relevant to research and higher education. It shall be common to all applicants for admission to the Ph.D Programme in IlmuAdvia and Moalajat.

The **Part 'A'** of the question paper shall be of **ONE hour duration**.

The Part 'B' of the Question Paper shall be devoted to the advance knowledge of subject concerned and that of the specialization (based on the prescribed syllabus for Mahir-e-Tib (M.D.) IlmuAdvia/Moalajat), if any. It shall have a weightage of 100 marks out of which 50 marks will be assigned to 50 multiple choice (objective type)

question of one mark each and a set of subjective types of questions having a weightage of another 50 marks.

The **Part 'B'** of the question paper shall be of **TWO hours duration**.

- 4. Interview :** The candidates who qualify the Entrance Test shall be required to prepare a **Research Proposal** and submit it to the Chairman BOS for Unani Medicine. The research proposal should include: (i) Broad Topic of Research, (ii) Objectives, (iii) Current State of the Literature related to the proposed topic, (iv) Proposed Research Work, (v) Methodology, (vi) References and (vii) Any other relevant information the researcher would like to submit.

The candidates who submit the Research Proposal, as per the schedule notified, shall be called for interview. These candidates will be required to be present and defend the research proposal before the Board of Studies.

The Board of Studies concerned, shall recommend the name of the candidates based on their performance, for the admission to the Ph.D. Programme, along with the name of a Supervisor and Co-supervisor (s). All such candidates shall be asked to contact the Office of the concerned Dean/HoD/Director to complete the admission formalities.

5. Reservation

Reservation Policy will be applicable as per JMI rule.

Candidates shall submit the following documents at the time of admission to the Ph.D. Programme:

- (a) Photograph of the candidate;
- (b) A Broad Research Proposal duly signed by the candidate on every page to be submitted to the Chairman, BOS for Unani Medicine prior to the Interview/specified date;
- (c) Proof of Permanent Residential Address;
- (d) Self-Attested copy of Matriculation (Class X)/equivalent for verification of date of birth;
- (e) Self-Attested copy of Graduation Degree;
- (f) Self-Attested copy of Post-Graduation Degree;
- (g) Category Certificate;

- (h) Character Certificate (in original), not more than 6 months old. In case the period extends more than 6 months then the candidate should submit a declaration certificate with respect to the intervening period, if any, after completing the qualifying course including the statement of character on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 10/- duly attested by the Notary Public or Oath Commissioner;
- (i) Migration Certificate (in original) must be provided within one month of the date of completion of admission, failing which admission is liable to be cancelled;
- (j) No Objection Certificate from the employer, if employed (in original);
- (k) If the candidate is unemployed, an Undertaking on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 10/- duly attested by Notary Public or Oath Commissioner.
- (l) A Consent Letter from the Co-Supervisor(s) specifying his/her field of specialization with full correspondence address.
