**Qualification for above posts (Sr. No. i to iv & vi to xi)**

**(a) Foundation Courses**

1. A Master's Degree in Science / Humanities / Arts with 50% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);
2. M. Ed. With at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and
3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC / any such affiliating body / State Government, from time to time for the positions of principal and lecturers, shall be mandatory;

**OR**

1. M. A. in Education with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);
2. B. Ed. with at least 55% (marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and

3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC / any such affiliating body / State Government, from time to time for the positions of principal and lecturers, shall be mandatory.

**(b) Methodology Courses**

1. A Master's Degree in subject with 50% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);
2. M. Ed. Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and
3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC / any such affiliating body / State Government, from time to time for the position of principal and lecturers, shall be mandatory.

**Qualification as per UGC guidelines**

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. "The award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-
  - a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
  - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
  - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
  - d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a referred journal;
  - e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/ Dean (University instructions).
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**Qualification for Asstt. Professor (contractual) Art Education :**

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. "The award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D

candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
  - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D thesis by at least two external examiners;
  - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
  - d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of Which at least one must be in a referred journal;
  - e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.
- (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice Chancellor/ Dean (Academic Affairs)/ Dean (University instructions).

- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**OR**

- i. A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:
  1. First class Diploma in Visual (Fine) arts discipline from the recognized Institution of India/Abroad;
  2. Five years of experience of holding regular regional/National exhibitions/Workshops with evidence; and
  3. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

**Qualification for Instructor (Tie & Dye):**

M.A. with at least 50% marks & B.Ed. with relevant craft or M.A. with at least 50% marks & 1 year Diploma in relevant craft.

2. The Department /Centres will screen the application of the candidates and will call for interview accordingly.
3. The engagement of the Asstt. Professor (contractual) & Guest Teachers will be w.e.f. the date of taking classes for the Academic Session 2017-18 or till vacancy exits or till further orders whichever is earlier.
4. Selection against vacancy shall not confer on the appointee any right of permanent appointment/regularization.
5. (a) The Jamia reserves the right to evolve a uniform and reasonable criterion for short-listing of eligible candidates, if needed.
