- 3. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC / any such affiliating body / State Government, from time to time for the positions of principal and lecturers, shall be mandatory;

- 1. M. A. in Education with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);
- 2. B. Ed. with at least 55% (marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and

Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

- 1. Ph.D./M.Phil in Education with research emphasis on Special Education.
- 2. Experience for a period of at least 3 years as teacher or researcher in the area of specific disability **or** 03-years of teaching experience at Diploma level.
