It symbolizes the unflinching and resolute commitment of these great visionaries in bringing about socio-economic transformation of common masses, in general, and Muslims, in particular through the vehicle of education. The distinct identity of Jamia Millia Islamia has been eloquently explicated by Dr. Zakir Husain Sahib.

Presently, Jamia has 9 Faculties, 39 Departments, 30 Centres of Excellence and Research, Over 18000 students enrolled in Certificate/Diploma, Undergraduate, Post-Graduate, M.Phil and Ph.D. courses.

**The Access Program:** The English Access Microscholarship Program provides a foundation of English language skills to talented 13 to 20 year olds from disadvantaged sectors through after-school classes and intensive summer camps. The two-year Access program gives participants English skills that lead to better jobs and educational prospects. Participants also gain the ability to compete for and participate in future exchanges and study in the U.S. The selected students attend regular school and come for the Access classes thrice a week after the school hours. The student teacher ratio is 25:1, and each session is of one and a half hours duration.

## Responsibilities

- To impart English language training to students from disadvantaged communities for 4.5 hours per week as per curriculum under the Access Program.
- To ensure routine documentation related to activities and thematic areas covered during teaching.
- To plan enhancement activities and projects geared around US and Indian culture/community service/personality development with the Access team
- Periodic assessment of student's performance and maintenance of attendance record

## Requirements

- 1-3 years of teaching experience in English language teaching
  - B.A/M.A (English/Journalism), preferably with a teaching certification
  - Willingness to learn and adopt new approaches to education
  - Willingness to commit time for participating in training sessions and commitment to continuous professional development
  - Ability to work in a multi cultural environment.
- Preference will be given to teachers who have had some formal training in English teaching.
