APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED FOR SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES FROM STUDENTS BELONGING TO SC/ST/OBC/MINORITY CATEGORY FOR THE YEAR 2016-17

SCHEME OPENING DATE: 01/12/2016 CLOSING DATE: 15/01/2017
Online applications are invited through e-district portal of Government of NCT of Delhi w.e.f 01/12/2016 for following scholarship schemes from the students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category in National Capital Territory of Delhi:-

1. Reimbursement of Tuition Fee for SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students studying in private schools in Delhi
2. Financial Assistance for purchase of stationary to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students (Class 1st to 12th)
3. Scholarship/Merit scholarship to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students studying in schools
4. Scholarship/Merit scholarship to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students studying in colleges/professional/ technical institutions.
5. Dr. B. R. Ambedkar State Toppers award to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students
6. Post - Matric Scholarship for OBC students (Centrally Sponsored Scheme, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India)
7. Pre - Matric Scholarship for OBC students (Centrally Sponsored Scheme, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India)

NOTE:
I. Schemes from serial number 1 to 5 above are State sponsored schemes.
II. Details of all above scholarship schemes i.e. eligibility criteria and amount of financial assistance etc. are available on the official website of the Department scstwelfare.delhigovt.nic.in.

How to APPLY:-

- I. These schemes may be applied through e-district portal of Government of NCT of Delhi. i.e. <http://edistrict.delhigovt.nic.in>
- II. Benefits under schemes mentioned at serial number 1, 2 and 3 above can be taken concurrently. However, school students can't apply for scholarship under both, State as well as Central schemes (Available on National Scholarship Portal 2.0 and edistrict portal) during the same year.
- III. For applying for any scholarship scheme, aadhaar number of the student and aadhaar seeded bank account of the student is required.
- IV. The applicant need to register on e-district portal of Government of NCT of Delhi i.e. <http://edistrict.delhigovt.nic.in> by using their aadhaar number or Epic card and select the scholarship scheme as per eligibility of the student and enter complete details of the applicant. If, applicant is already registered on e-district portal, he/she may directly login for applying scholarship as per student's eligibility criteria.
- V. The applicant will fill in all details as per their records and upload photograph and certified copy of all required documents as per selected scheme.
- VI. Records filled by students will be forwarded to the login of respective Schools/ Institutes/ Universities. The Head/Principal/Registrar of Schools/Institutes/ Universities shall login into the portal in order to examine the beneficiary details and shall validate, authorize & approve the student records. Thereafter, Zonal/District/HQs of the respective administrative department will validate and approve the records and forward to the Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC/Minority for further necessary action.
- VII. For operating the portal, the school/college/technical institution may approach their respective administrative Department i.e. Directorate of Education/ Directorate of Higher Education/Directorate of Technical Education, for obtaining login ID and password after 01/12/2016.
- VIII. Model officer of the respective Schools/Institutes/University will be squarely responsible to enter the accurate DIAS/HIAS/AISHE Code of its institution and all the courses, programs etc. offered by them. This will help the beneficiary student to select his/her School in a single click at the Portal.
- IX. Students are advised to keep the printout of online application form for future reference.
- X. The students who are residents of Delhi but are studying in the educational institutions, situated outside Delhi (only applicable for scheme number 4 and 6 above), may apply online and take a printout of application form and get it verified from the concerned institute in the prescribed form of certificate available as part of online application form and further upload it on the portal. Thereafter, they should submit hard copy of application form alongwith required documents in the Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC/Minority, B Block, Vikas Bhawan, 1 P Estate, New Delhi-2 within 30 days by registered post/courier only addressed to Deputy Director (Scholarship), Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC, B Block, Vikas Bhawan, 1st Floor, 1 P Estate, New Delhi-110002.

For Educational Institutions:-

They should remain in touch with their concerned administrative department to stay abreast with the latest instructions, guidelines, schedules of training etc. for successful operationalization of the scheme.
The school/college/technical institution may submit the requisite details namely, details of school/college/ institutes along with address, district, zone, pin code, contact, School ID, DISE Code/AISHE Code, Affiliation/ recognition details, and also a mail ID, name and mobile number of authorised representative of the school in the letter head of the school/college/technical institution in case their name is not appearing in the list available on the portal

1. Reimbursement of tuition fee for students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category for the year 2016-17 studying in class 1 st to class 12 th in private recognised schools in Delhi

Eligibility criteria:-

- a. The students studying in class I to class XII in private recognised schools in Delhi whose parents/guardians annual Income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two Lakh Only)
- b. Students with parents/guardian's income upto Rs. 60,000/- per annum will be eligible for 100 % reimbursement of tuition fee while those with parents/guardian's income between Rs. 60,000/- to 2,00,000/- per annum will be eligible for 75 % reimbursement of tuition fee.
- c. The students studying in class 1st to class 5th will be entitled for reimbursement of tuition fee regardless of marks, but in case of students studying in class 6th to 12th, tuition fee will be reimbursed to only those scoring 50 % and above marks
- d. All students require a minimum of 80 % attendance in the preceding year.

Note: Applicant should upload fee receipts in original for first six months i.e. April, 2016 to September, 2016 or for the whole year, if already paid.

2. Financial assistance for purchase of stationary to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students studying in Class I to XII

Eligibility criteria:-

- a. The student should not have less than 70% attendance in previous academic year.
- b. Parents/guardians annual Income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two Lakh Only)
- c. Rates of financial assistance:-
 - i. Students class 1st to class 8th- Rs. 1000/- per annum
 - ii. Students class 9th to class 12th- Rs. 2000/- per annum

Note: The students studying in recognised private schools in Delhi may apply individually through e-district portal.

In case of students studying in government schools recognised/affiliated to Directorate of Education/ East Delhi Municipal Corporation/ North Delhi Municipal Corporation/ South Delhi Municipal Corporation/ NDMC/Delhi Cantonment Board/Kendriya VidyalayaSangathan, the school authority will scrutinize the eligible applicants and will prepare consolidated list of eligible beneficiaries and upload bulk data on the portal.

3. Scholarship/Merit Scholarship to students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority Category studying in Schools

Eligibility criteria for Scholarship:-

- a) The Scholarship will be given to the students pursuing studies (Class 1st to 12th for SC/ST/MINORITY and class 6th to 12th for OBC students) from all recognised schools in Delhi, private as well as govt.
- b) Family income limit is not applicable in case of SC/ST students but family income should not exceed Rs. 2.00 lakh per annum in case of OBC/MINORITY students.

In case of students studying in government schools recognised/affiliated to Directorate of Education/ East Delhi Municipal Corporation/ North Delhi Municipal Corporation/ South Delhi Municipal Corporation/ NDMC/Delhi Cantonment Board/Kendriya VidyalayaSangathan, the school authority will scrutinize the eligible applicants and will prepare consolidated list of eligible beneficiaries and upload bulk data on the portal.

4. Merit Scholarship for students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MINORITY category studying in Colleges/Professional/Technical Institutions.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

- a) SC/ST/OBC/MINORITY students should have obtained 60% or more marks in previous academic year.
- b) Scholarships are available to students pursuing any Degree/Diploma Course /Post Graduate Studies or any Professional/Technical Courses from recognized/affiliated Colleges/Institutes of the State/Central Govt.

- (i) Diploma level courses in Indian medicine, B.A.M.S & comparable courses in Ayurveda, Unani/Tibbi and Homeopathic system of medicine
- (ii) Diploma level course in Engineering Technology, Architecture, Printing Technology, Overseas, Draftsman Surveyor, Hotel Management, Catering, Applied Nutrition, Commercial Pilot License Wireless & T.V Operator Sound Recording & Engineering, Photography, Film Direction, Acting, Screenplay Writing.

5. Dr. B. R. Ambedkar State Toppers Award to students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category (for the professional/technical degree courses at the graduation level).
I. The award is given to the student, who tops amongst the SC/ST/OBC/Minority category students in each discipline of the professional/technical degree course. An award of Rs. 8,000/- is given to each of the toppers at the graduation level.
II. The college/university/technical institution may ensure that all deserving students are covered under this scheme. Extra efforts need to be made by them in helping the students in applying on e-district portal.

6. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for OBC Students Studying in Delhi and also outside Delhi but within India (2016-17) (Centrally Sponsored scholarship scheme- Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment)

Eligibility criteria:-

1. Scholarship is available to all OBC category students of Delhi whose parents/guardian's income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 1 lakh per annum and who are pursuing studies in Govt. recognized institutions situated in Delhi or outside Delhi but within India during the academic year (2016-17).
 2. The eligibility of applicants will be decided and scholarship will be granted as per guidelines/ notification /circular issued by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India/ Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC from time to time.
7. Pre-Matric Scholarship to Students belonging to other backward category, studying in class I to X (2015-16) (Sponsored by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India)

ELIGIBILITY:

- a) Scholarship will be granted to the students belonging to OBC category of Delhi, studying in class I to X in government/ government aided/ recognised private schools in Delhi.
- b) Scholarship will be granted to the students studying in class I to class X and whose parents/guardians annual Income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 44,500/- (Rs. Forty Four Thousand and Five Hundred Only.)
