8(i)	A candidate enrolled in the Ph.D. course will be required to submit his/her thesis not earlier than two years but not later than five years. Provided that the Board of Studies/ Committee of Studies, after the expiry of five years period, may grant an extension for a period of one year on the recommendations of the Supervisor concerned. If the candidate fails to submit his/ her Ph.D. Thesis within the extended period of one year, an extension of another year may be granted by the Vice – Chancellor on the basis of the recommendation of the Board of Studies/ Committee of Studies.	A candidate enrolled in the Ph.D. course will be required to submit his/her thesis not earlier than two years but not later than five years. Provided that the Board of Studies/ Committee of Studies, after the expiry of the five year period, may grant an extension for a period of one year on the recommendations of the Supervisor concerned. The Supervisor/ Co — Supervisor of the said candidate shall ensure that the candidate include the suggestion made during the Seminar presentation in his/ her thesis before is finally submitted.	Every Ph. D. student shall give a Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar at least six months before the submission of the thesis. Provided that the Head/ Dean/ Director of the Department/ Faculty/ Centre concerned shall make the arrangements for the above presentation. The Supervisor/ Co — Supervisor of the said candidate shall ensure that the candidate include(s) the suggestion(s) made during the Seminar presentation in his/ her thesis before it is finally submitted. For the purpose of clarity, it is hereby provided that, The thesis may be submitted even before the expiry of six months period from the date of Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar provided that the Supervisor/Co-

The candidate may submit his/her thesis even beyond the expiry of six months since the date of Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar with the approval of the Supervisor/Co-Supervisor and the Head/Dean/Director concerned. However, the maximum period granted to the candidate shall not exceed twelve (12) months from the date of Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar.

In case the candidate is not able to submit his/her thesis within the twelve (12) month period, he/she shall be required to make a fresh Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar.
