Confirmation of Minutes:

1. A letter was received by Ms. Yasmeen Khan requested for the changes. These have been incorporated in syllabus:
 - i. Maintenance and welfare of parents and senior citizens Act 2007.
 - ii. Ladli Scheme rules 2008 for girl child in Delhi. To enhance the social status of girl child in society as well as in the family.
 - iii. Crime against women cells-guidelines issued by Justice Gambhir of Delhi High Court regarding filing an FIR 498A- FIR to be registered after approval of the DCP and only against the Husband.
 - iv. Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights.

The above have been incorporated in the syllabus. No other comments were received and the minutes of 10th October 2008 meeting was approved.
