National Law Reform Competition
Rules of the Competition

1. Teams shall be registered in the name of the Institution. The names of the three members of the participating team must be printed on the first page of the draft Proposal.
2. The participating team may consist of **three members**, though it was mentioned as two in the initial communication. So also, the team coming to Jamia to defend the proposal shall consist of a **maximum of three members**.
2. Presentation of the draft proposal
 - a) The draft proposal shall be presented in the form of a **Report** (Like the Law Commission Report).
 - b) The Report shall not be more than 50 pages.
 - c) The Report shall be printed on A4 size paper with 12 point, Times New Roman Fonts and with 1.5 line spacing. The whole Report and cover shall be printed on white paper only.
 - d) Each team shall ensure that Two copies of their Report reaches the Faculty of Law, Jamia Millia Islamia on or before March 7, 2011.
 - e) The Front page should contain the title of the Report and other details of the participating team. Except on the cover page identification of the Institution/team is not allowed any where else in the Report.
 - f) The Report should be spiral bound, with only plain transparent plastic sheet in the front and back.
 - g) Foot-notes and citations shall be in the Indian Law Institute, New Delhi citation format.
3. Defending the proposal/Report
 - a) A maximum of 30 minutes will be given to each team to present the Report and to answer the questions by the jury.
 - b) After the First Round of presentations, the best **five teams** will be selected for **the Final Round**.
4. Prizes
 - There will be Three Prizes (Trophies and Certificates) for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd winning teams, with a cash award of Rs. 12,000/-, 9,000/- and 6,000/- respectively.
 - Participation Certificates and Mementoes will be to all participants.
 - The Best team will be adjudged based on the Written Report and Oral Presentation.
5. Accommodation will be limited to participants from outside Delhi from March 24 evening to March 28. Teams from Delhi and the NCR will not be provided accommodation. All travel expenses for teams from Delhi/NCR and outside Delhi will have to be met by the participating team/Institution.
