**Free Mask and sanitizer distribution under “Corona Prevention Campaign” at Faculty of Dentistry,  
Jamia Millia Islamia**

In continuation of the Covid-19 sensitization and awareness activities under the *University Grants Commission (UGC)* during the on-going pandemic, the Faculty of Dentistry, Jamia Millia Islamia organised free distribution of masks and sanitizers to the patients.

The “*Corona Prevention Campaign*” for free mask and sanitizer distribution was done today at the patient reception area of the faculty where Dr. Nazim Husain Al-Jafri, Registrar and Controller of Examinations, JMI distributed hand sanitizers and face masks to the patients reporting for the treatment at the Faculty.

Prof Sanjay Singh, Dean, Faculty of Dentistry, along with the Incharges of all the departments, the staff members and interns working at the reception and the general OPD were present during the programme.
