52. Future plans of the Department

- Observation reveal that after completing 10+ or graduation, most students lack adequate information regarding proper coaching facilities available to them. In this process, more often than not, they remain without a proper institutional support that may help them prepare for furtherance of their careers. It is for this purpose that the Centre offers a variety of coaching programmes for entering into services and seeking admission to various professional courses. Some of the remedial and competitive programmes being offered by the Centre include:
