Tomoyoshi Nozaki is Professor in Graduate school of Medicine, University of Tokyo. He has been in various position till now, like Director of prestigious Parasitology at National institute for Infectious Diseases. His major research interests include virulence mechanisms and metabolism of protozoa, particularly Entamoeba histolytica causing amebic dysentery and Plasmodium spp. causing malaria. His group is actively working on vesicular trafficking, phagocytosis, autophagy, proteases, amino metabolisms, RNA maturation, translation, development, and organellogenesis of E. histolytica. His laboratory uses approaches from various fields like biochemistry, molecular and cell biology, live imaging, multi-omics including metabolomics, and reverse genetics to address the research problems.
