Tomoyoshi Nozaki is Professor in Graduate school of Medicine, University of Tokyo. He has been in various prestigious position till now, like Director of Parasitology at National institute for Infectious Diseases. His major research interests include virulence mechanisms and metabolism of protozoa, particularly *Entamoeba histolytica* causing amebic dysentery and *Plasmodium* spp. causing malaria. His group is actively working on vesicular trafficking, phagocytosis, autophagy, proteases, amino acid metabolisms, RNA maturation, translation, drug development, and organellogenesis of *E. histolytica*. His laboratory uses approaches from various fields like biochemistry, molecular and cell biology, live imaging, multi-omics including metabolomics, and reverse genetics to address the research problems.
