



conventional method of delivering notices for publishing the website manually. This process has been quite time consuming required considerable man hours to accomplish the job.



The Windows Software Update Services (WSUS 3.0) was installed at made functional. The WSUS enables central deployment of the latest Microsoft product updates to Windows. MS-Office and other Microsoft's products. It provides an economical way for keeping the machines up to date as it fetches all the required software updates from Microsoft servers and passes on to the local client machines that need them. The machines with the latest software updates and patches installed on them are less vulnerable to malicious activities. 




Open Source Network Management System

To monitor the Jamia network continuously for disruptions and other network events, an Open Source Software – OpenNMS was installed and made functional. OpenNMS is the first enterprise-grade network management platform developed under the open-source model. Currently, OpenNMS focuses on three main areas:

- Service Polling Determining service availability and reporting on same.
- Data Collection Collecting, storing and reporting on network information as well as generating thresholds.
- Event and Notification Management Receiving events, both internal and external, and using those events to feed a robust notification system, including escalation.


MIS Update: Admission seekers in Jamia on the rise

As per the MIS entry of admission forms in various postgraduate, undergraduate, diploma and certificate courses in the Faculties, Centres and Schools of Jamia for the session 2009-2010, there were 1,26,199 applicants. This shows an increases of 22% in the number of applicants from 2008-2009 and 33% from 2007-2008. Their break-up for 2007, 2008 and 2009 are given in the following:


A graphical representation of sumary of Admission Forms in the MIS during 2007-2008, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010.


Website Visits


Connectivity Restoration/Alteration


The following restoration/alteration operations were performed on the network:


- The Department of Social Work was provided connectivity through OFC. Earlier the connectivity was only through UTP cables.

 - d. Department of Social Work


Internet Bandwidth Utilization
