

Curriculum and Teaching-Learning Process


The Program curriculum of each discipline is based on the AICTE model curriculum which is validated by the members of Board of Studies. A syllabus committee consisting of the faculty members, senior academicians of other institutes, industry experts, and alumni is setup by the HOD to review the existing curriculum and syllabus. The syllabus committee is further split into sub-committees of thrust areas of the program. The curriculum is discussed and finalised by the sub-committees keeping an eye on contents of GATE, ESE and UPSC syllabi and further place before the committee. The finalized curriculum and syllabus are placed before the Board of Studies for endorsement to the Faculty Committee. The recommendations of the Faculty Committee are then placed to the Academic council for approval.

Program Outcomes (POs) and the Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs) are also considered while designing the program curriculum.
