THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS SIGNED BETWEEN:

Jamia Millia Islamia, a Central University created by an enactment of the Parliament of India (i.e. the Jamia Millia Islamia Act, 1988) and is a body corporate with a perpetual succession and a common seal (acting through its Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Talat Ahmad)

AND

The Purbanchal University, Biratnagar, Nepal is established by the act of Nepalese Parliament in the year 1993 was visualized as an extraordinary endeavour by the Government of Nepal to create an academic centre of excellence in the Eastern Development Region of Nepal, having its Central Office in Biratnagar, Nepal

AND WHEREAS it is the statutory object of the Jamia Millia Islamia University to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional, research and extension facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit and it shall endeavor to provide to students and teachers the necessary atmosphere and facilities for the promotion of:

- (i) Innovations in education leading to restructuring of courses, new methods of teaching and learning and integral development of personality.
- (ii) Studies in various disciplines.
- (iii) Inter disciplinary studies.
- (iv) National integration, secularism and international understanding.

NOW THEREFORE the Jamia Millia Islamia and Purbanchal University have intended, agreed and consented to **following terms and deeds** in pursuance of a common intent. Now, therefore, both the Universities agree to bind themselves with the following provisions to give effect to the Institutional Linkage in the most effective manner.

1. FIELD OF COOPERATION:

- (i) Both the institutions shall evolve a mutually acceptable schedule to develop programme, hold seminars and exchange visits.



- (ii) The said academic interaction and intellectual assimilation may include-
- (iii) Faculty/Staff development and exchange;
- (iv) Exchange of Students;
- (v) Seminars, research, conferences and workshops;
- (vi) Collaborations in the sharing of academic data's, scientific information, intellectual property, articles and publications;
- (vii) Advice surgeries, placements and executive training;

2. EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS/TEACHERS:

- a) Reciprocal arrangements based and mutually acceptable terms shall be accomplished to give and impetus to collaborative research and joint projects. Teachers, researchers, guides and student of both the institutions shall be encouraged to work in tandem in the laboratories, workshops, faculties and departments of both the institutions.
- b) Issue relating to travel, boarding, lodging, miscellaneous expenses shall vary according to the rules, regulations and policies of every institution.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a) The details for the efficacious implementations of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- b) The parties to this Memorandum may, by mutual consent, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of this Agreement.
- c) The intent and implementation of this Memorandum is **SUBJECT** to the policies of the respective States and the laws of the land.
- d) This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for period of 5 (five) years from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months Notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the Notice of the intent to terminate the Memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties flowing and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalisation and accomplishment thereof.



- e) The parties to this memorandum of Understanding undertake to treat as “**confidential and privileged**” information of the other institution which is so classified in advance. The terms of Confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.
- f) This Memorandum of Understanding shall require the ratification of the competent academic/ executive body of both the institution.
