Climate Action for a Sustainable Future

The Academy of Professional Development of Urdu Medium Teachers (APDUMT), Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi, organized a Special Lecture on "Climate Action for a Sustainable Future" on the occasion of World Environment Day on 5 June 2026 at 3:00 PM through online mode. The programme was organized for school teachers, pre-service teachers, research scholars, and other stakeholders with the objective of promoting awareness about environmental sustainability and encouraging meaningful climate action. The academy thanks to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. Mazhar Asif and Hon'ble Registrar, Prof. Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi for rejuvenating the academic environment of the University in which such programmes are being organized effectively.

The session commenced with opening remarks by Dr. Naushad Alam, Coordinator of the session, Translator, APDUMT, JMI. He welcomed the participants and highlighted the importance of observing World Environment Day as a platform to reflect on environmental challenges and collective responsibilities. The lecture started with Qirat by Mr. Taj Mohammad, a scholar of Jamia Millia Islamia. Following this, Dr. Hina Afreen, Assistant Professor, APDUMT, introduced the guest speaker, Dr. Md. Afroz Alam (MANUU, CTE, Darbhanga), outlining his academic achievements and contributions in the field of environmental studies and academia.

Dr. Alam explained the growing concerns related to global warming, environmental degradation, pollution, and the excessive exploitation of natural resources with the latest data from various reports of the UN, UNDP, IUCN etc. He discussed the role of international organizations such as the United Nations Environment Programme in promoting environmental protection and sustainable development across the world. He stressed that climate change is a global issue that affects every nation and therefore requires coordinated efforts at both national and international levels.

A key theme of the lecture was the growing problem of excessive resource consumption. Dr. Alam explained that humanity is consuming natural resources at an unprecedented rate. This overconsumption not only leads to resource depletion but also contributes to biodiversity loss, environmental degradation, and negative impacts on vulnerable communities.

Another important issue highlighted during the lecture was inequality in resource consumption among countries. Dr. Alam pointed out that while some countries consume resources at very high levels, many others have limited access to them. He stressed that achieving sustainability requires addressing these inequalities and ensuring fair and responsible use of resources across the globe.

The speaker concluded his lecture with several measures for moving forward, including strengthening environmental education, promoting green technologies and renewable energy, encouraging sustainable lifestyles, enhancing international cooperation, increasing community

participation, supporting research and innovation, and ensuring the strict implementation of environmental laws and policies. He also highlighted the significant role of teachers and students in environmental conservation.

The participants equally participated in the programme via chatbox where they appreciated the speaker for such impactful talk as well as highlighted issues like 'Net zero target', 'Electricity misuse' and 'change in lifestyle' for protecting the environment.

At the end of the session, Prof. Jasim Ahmad, Hony. Director of the Academy, delivered the Chair's remarks and appreciated Dr. Afroz Alam for his well-structured and engaging presentation. He emphasized that discussions on climate change should move beyond awareness and inspire meaningful action. Such sessions, he noted, are essential not only for expanding knowledge but also for encouraging individuals to adopt environmentally responsible practices. He reminded the participants that environmental protection is ultimately linked to our own safety and well-being. Prof. Ahmad also reflected on the impact of the Industrial Revolution, highlighting its contribution to rising global temperatures and increasing carbon dioxide emissions. He stressed that addressing climate change requires collective efforts at every level from individual actions to global cooperation.

The session concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Hina Afreen. The programme was attended by Urdu-medium teachers from across the country, along with teacher educators and research scholars, whose presence contributed to the success of the event. The session ended with a renewed commitment among participants to adopt sustainable practices and contribute towards environmental conservation.
