The following is the suggested format for paper submissions

1. Length: 3500–5000 words or 10–12 pages
2. Paper title should be brief and clear
3. Provide all authors' title (e.g., Dr., Mr., Mrs., etc.), name, affiliation, email address and ORCID
4. Abstract (not more than 250 words) and keywords
5. Introduction / Background / Objectives
6. Literature Review
7. Methodology, Findings, Analysis, and Discussion
8. Conclusion, Limitations, and Recommendations
9. References: APA 7th edition style required
10. Tables, figures, etc. should be placed in their appropriate location in the paper (if applicable)
11. Margins: 1 inch or 2.5 cm
12. Font: Times New Roman, 12-point size
13. Spacing: 1.5 between lines and 2 between paragraphs

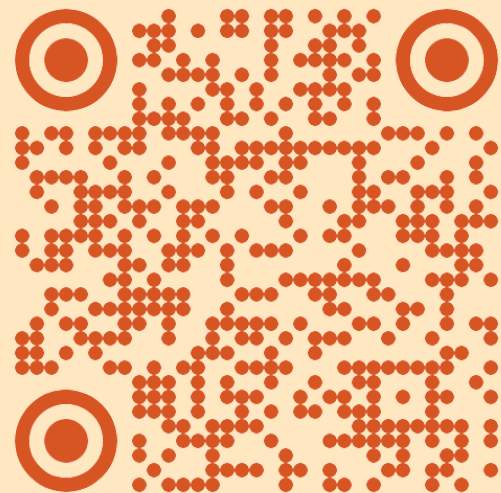
