Participants are expected to write a **1500-2000 word essay in English** on the spot. They will subsequently make an oral presentation in English, of five minutes each, based on their written work.

Winners would be declared in a function to be held on 30 November 2011.

Two students (one female and one male) will be selected as winners on the basis of the essay writing competition. The prize for the winners of this event will be a **one-week study tour to the United Kingdom** sponsored fully by the Foreign & Commonwealth Office, British High Commission to India. The study tour will include visits to historic sites, cultural events, interaction with experts on diversity issues and academic lectures.
