PROF. SANJAY P. ZODPEY, M.B.B.S., M.D., Ph.D.

Prof Sanjay P. Zodpey is a Medical Scientist, Public Health Specialist, and Epidemiologist. He has done his MBBS, MD and PhD in Preventive and Social Medicine from Government Medical College, Nagpur, Maharashtra, India. He has been awarded Fellowship of Indian Public Health Association (IPHA) and Indian Association of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM). He is currently working as a Director, Public Health Education, Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI), New Delhi and the Director at the Indian Institute of Public Health, Delhi and Bhubaneswar. He has a vast research experience in partnership with national and international agencies, development partners, governments and contract research organizations. He has been an investigator for more than 40 research projects. Prof. Zodpey has over 145 scientific publications in reputed national and international journals to his credit.

PROF. RITU PRIYA MEHROTRA, M.B.B.S., Ph.D.

Prof. Ritu Priya Mehrotra has done MBBS and PhD in Community Health. Currently, she is working as a Professor at Centre for Social Medicine and Community Health, School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University. Her areas of interest include Public policy formulation and analysis interlinking epidemiology, political economy & health culture, Communicable disease control programmes, Nutrition & health, Impact of public policies on health of migrant labour, the urban poor and dalit groups, Interdisciplinary health research methodology and Holistic Epidemiology. She has been a faculty member at the Centre of Social Medicine and Community Health, Jawaharlal Nehru University, since 1990 and Advisor, Public Health Planning at the National Health Systems Resource Centre (National Rural Health Mission, Min. of Health & Family welfare, GOI) on deputation, 2008 & 2009.

PROF. JAMES WARNER BJÖRKMAN, M.Phil.,Ph.D.

Prof. James Warner Björkman is a Professor Emeritus of Public Policy and Administration at the Institute of Social Studies, Hague. He chairs the International Political Science Association Research Committee on Comparative Health Policy. He is an alumni of University of Minnesota and Yale University where he completed his PhD. He served as Professor of Public Administration and Development at Leiden State University and a visiting Professor at the University of Namibia in Windhoek as well as the International Centre for the Promotion of Enterprise in Ljubljana, Slovenia. Previously, he was the faculty member at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and Executive Director of the International Institute of Comparative Government in Lausanne, Switzerland. He directed the American Studies Research Centre, Hyderabad, India, and was Deputy Rector of the Institute of Social Studies. He has published 14 books and more than 80 journal articles and reviews.

PROF. BRUCE H. ALEXANDER, M.S., Ph.D.

Bruce H. Alexander, Professor and Head of the Division of Environmental Health Sciences, School of Public Health at the University of Minnesota, is an occupational and environmental epidemiologist with research interests in environmental determinants of cancer and respiratory disease, injury prevention and control, One Health and the health of agricultural populations, and global health. Dr. Alexander is the Director of the Upper Midwest Agricultural Safety and Health Center, Director of the Occupational and Environmental Epidemiology Training Program and

Co-Director of the Occupational Injury Prevention and Research Training program in the Midwest Center for Occupational Health and Safety. Dr. Alexander holds a PhD in epidemiology from the University of Washington, and MS and BS in environmental health from Colorado State University.

Dr. BENJAMIN D. CAPISTRANT, ScM, ScD.

Dr. Capistrant is an Assistant Professor in Epidemiology & Community Health, University of Minnesota, Minneapolis. He has completed his B.A. History and Political Science, concentration in African Studies, Boston University, Boston and holds ScD in Social Epidemiology and ScM, Society, Human Development and Health, Harvard University, Cambridge. His research interests are Social Epidemiology of Aging and Non-Communicable Diseases=Demography of Aging=Disability=Cardiovascular Disease=Global Health=Caregiving=Families=Health Disparities (incl. socioeconomic and racial/ethnic). He has been awarded Aging, CNS, and Mobility in Older Adults Workshop, Junior Investigator Travel Award (competitive) 2012, Hewlett Foundation/IIE Dissertation Fellowship 2011-2012, Harvard CVD Epidemiology Fellow/Trainee Award, Finalist 2011, RAND Summer Institute on Aging, Travel Award (competitive) 2010, American Heart Association, Founders Affiliate, Pre Doctoral Fellowship 2009-2011 and Founders Grant, Boston University 1999 6 2003. He has various peer reviewed publications to his credit.

PROF. BETH VIRNIG, M.P.H., Ph.D.

Dr. Beth Virnig is a PhD, MPH, Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and Research, School of Public Health, University of Minnesota. She has been involved in the research that examines the use of health care by the elderly in the Medicare program with a focus on hospice use, cancer surveillance and care, and Medicare managed care. She is known for her scholarly work related to cancer care effectiveness and quality including end of life care. Currently, her focuses is on comparing cancer care and outcomes and extending knowledge of factors and consequences associated with optimal and suboptimal patterns of care. Her expertise on the use of Medicare, linked SEER-Medicare and other large databases for health services research has drawn national attention. She is involved with the linkage and application of Medicare data to several large cohorts including the Iowa Womenøs Health Study, the Study of Osteoporotic Fractures, the Womenøs Health Initiative and the Breast Cancer Surveillance Consortium. She has been an investigator on the Research Data Assistance Center since 1998. She has over 120 peer-reviewed publications to her credit.

PROF. GURUMURTHY RAMACHANDRAN M.S., Ph.D.

Dr. Gurumurthy Ramachandran is a Professor in the Division of Environmental Health Sciences in the School of Public Health at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis where he has conducted research in various areas relating to human exposure assessment in occupational and non-occupational settings. His research has included the development of robust occupational exposure assessment strategies for a variety of airborne contaminants. He has pioneered the use of novel Bayesian statistical methods that synthesize exposure models, monitoring data, and probabilistic expert judgment. He has been at the forefront of research in occupational hygiene decision-making, and developing mathematical methods for exposure modeling and analyzing occupational measurements. Additional areas of expertise include developing exposure assessment methods for nanoparticles and the use of expert judgement in risk assessment for nanomaterials, and nanotechnology policy in the areas of occupational health and nanomedicine.

He has served as a member of the Board of Scientific Counselors to the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) and advisory committees for the National Academy of Sciences (NAS) and the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). He is also serving on the editorial boards of the Journal of Occupational and Environmental Hygiene, and Journal of Occupational Safety and Health. He has a Bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay, a Master's degree in Environmental Engineering, and a Ph. D. in Environmental Sciences and Engineering from the University of North Carolina.

PROF. NAIMATULLAH KHAN, M.S.W., Ph.D.

Dr. N.U. Khan is a Professor and Head of the Department of Social Work, Faculty of Social Sciences, Jamia Millia Islamia. He earned a Doctorate in Industrial Relations from Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi, India. His areas of specialization are social research, social development, welfare management and human resource management. He has completed many research projects and has also published books and articles in reputated journals. He is also the programme coordinator of NSS and NCC in Jamia Millia Islamia.
