Duration of Programme

Two-Weeks Online Refresher Course is spread over 12 working days and 72 contact hours (six hours a day, six days a week), excluding Sundays.

Eligibility for Participation

All in service teachers in higher education working in universities and colleges that are included under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, even though they may not yet be fit under Section 12 (B), are invited to participate in the programme. The teachers of colleges that do not yet come within the purview of Section 2(f), but have been affiliated to a university for at least five years, will be permitted to participate. Faculty Members working in Institutes of National importance are also eligible to participate.

Certificate Criteria

To receive the E-certificate, participants must attend all the sessions; submit individual/group assignments; take tests or do the other exercises for evaluation purposes, as mandated.

Course will be relevant for Faculty Members from the department of Arabic, Persian and Sanskrit.
