The body of your abstract begins here. It should be an explicit summary of your presentation that states the problem, the methods used, and the major results and conclusions. Do not include scientific symbols, acronyms, numbers, bullets or lists in the abstract. It should be single-spaced in 12-point Times New Roman.

An abstract is single/multiple paragraphs, without indentation, compendious summary of a paper's substance including research question, background, purpose, methodology, results, and conclusion in 175 to 275 words. The main text, like the author names used Times New Roman font, 14 point for the Author names and 12 point for the remainder of the abstract. Type or paste your text into this files, but remembers to keep the page margins the same as 2.5 cm all round. Paragraphs are justified (straight-edged) on both left and right.

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
