NOTIFICATION

In light of the order dated 09.05.2016 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P. (C) No. 261 of 2016 titled 'Sankalp Charitable Trust & Anr. v. Union of India & Anr.', it is hereby informed to all concerned that the entrance examination of the Jamia Millia Islamia scheduled to be held on 03.06.2016 for admission to the BDS course stands cancelled. All prospective candidates who are desirous of gaining admission to the BDS course for the academic year 2016-17 are hereby informed that they are required to appear in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) administered by the CBSE.

Jamia will use NEET All India rankings for selection under existing admission/reservation policy of the University. Further the application for BDS programme for the academic year 2016-17 shall be reopened for desirous candidates from 1st June to 15th June, 2016 on the website (www.jmi.ac.in).

Note: A. Applicants already registered with Jamia for BDS admission:

1. Must take NEET examination.
2. Those who have not appeared in NEET-1 (AIPMT) must appear in NEET-2 for being considered for admission.
3. Submit online NEET Roll No. through our website.

B. Applicants not already registered for Jamia's BDS admission:

1. Must register for BDS admission process being reopened from 1st June to 15th June, 2016.
2. Must take NEET examination.
3. Those who have not appeared in NEET-1 (AIPMT) must appear in NEET-2 for being considered for admission.
4. Submit online NEET Roll No. through our website.
