NOTIFICATION

The Vice-Chancellor, JMI on behalf of *Majlis-i-Talimi* (Academic Council) of the University, has approved the following amendment in the Ordinance 15-C (XV-C) 'University Examinations in Programmes Regulated by Statutory Bodies (Academic)' under B.Tech. programme:

Existing Provision	Amended Provision
22.5 A minor and honors degree will run if the minimum number of registered students is not less than 12 at the time of registration. The maximum number of students permitted to enroll a minor degree course will be 120 (two sections of 60 each).	22.5 A minor and honors degree will run if the minimum number of registered students is not less than 12 at the time of registration. The maximum number of students permitted to enroll a minor degree course will be 90.
24.1 The student may opt out of the honors degree by submitting an application to the Head of the Department duly forwarded by the Department Coordinator. The student may opt out of the Minor degree by submitting an application to the Dean of the Faculty duly forwarded by the Department Coordinator and Head of the Department. The Head of the Department/Dean shall consider such cases and may de-register the concerned student from Minor/Honors based on merits of the case.	24.1 A student may opt out of the Honors degree by submitting application to the Head of the Department through the Department Coordinator. Similarly, a student may withdraw from the Minor degree by submitting application to the Dean of the Faculty, duly forwarded by the Department Coordinator and the Head of the Department. The Head of the Department/Dean, as applicable, shall review such requests and may approve the de-registration of the concerned student from the Minor/Honors program.
24.2 The last date for submission of such application shall be before the commencement of the classes for the fourth semester.	24.2 The student must submit the application for de-registration before the last date for submission of the examination form of the 4 th semester. If a student seeks withdrawal after this date or in any subsequent semester, the request may be permitted; however, the Honors/Minor degree shall not be awarded, and the courses already registered in the examination form will be reflected as 'Fail/Pass/Withdrawn' in the grade sheet.
24.3 Once the student has been selected for any minor or honors degree and has not applied for de-registration before the last date and his/her registration has not been cancelled, he/she shall become a regular student of the minor or honors degree.	-----Deleted-----

Existing Provision	Amended Provision
26.2 A regular student will become eligible to be awarded honors after completion of 18 additional credits over and above the requirement for a B.Tech. Degree (163 credits) with an overall CGPA of 8 or above, excluding the Honors courses.	26.2 A regular student shall be eligible for the award of an Honors degree upon successful completion of 18 additional credits over and above the prescribed requirement for the B.Tech. degree (163 credits), provided that the student has secured an overall CGPA of 8.0 or higher. For students who have opted for a Minor/Honors, the marksheet will reflect only the number of credits earned and the Pass/Fail status in the respective course/subject. No grades shall be awarded for the Honors courses completed by the student.
26.3 The credits earned by the students in Minor/Honors courses will not be counted for promotion, as per clause 8 of this Ordinance	26.3 The credits earned by the students in Minor/Honors courses will not be counted for promotion, as per clause 8 of this Ordinance.
26.4 The grades obtained by the students in the courses of minor degree will not be considered for CGPA calculations.	-----Deleted-----
