- 2. MBA (Pharmaceutical Management)**

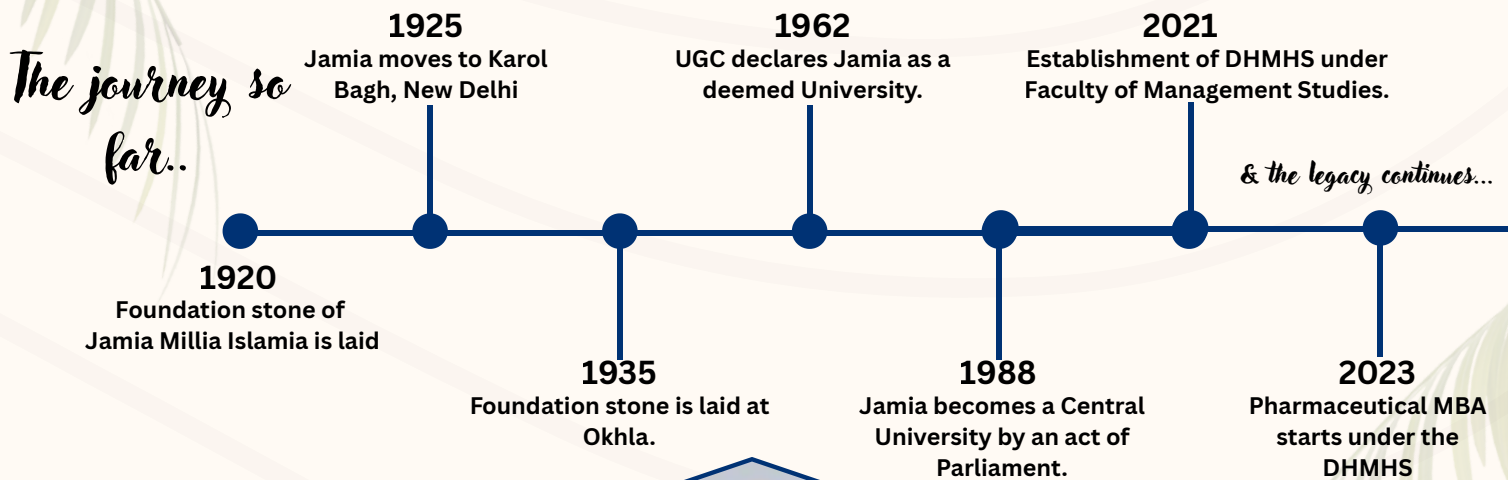

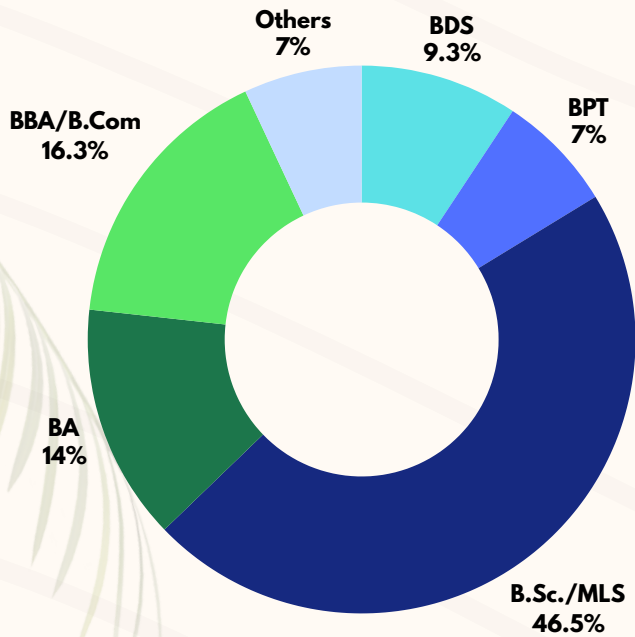

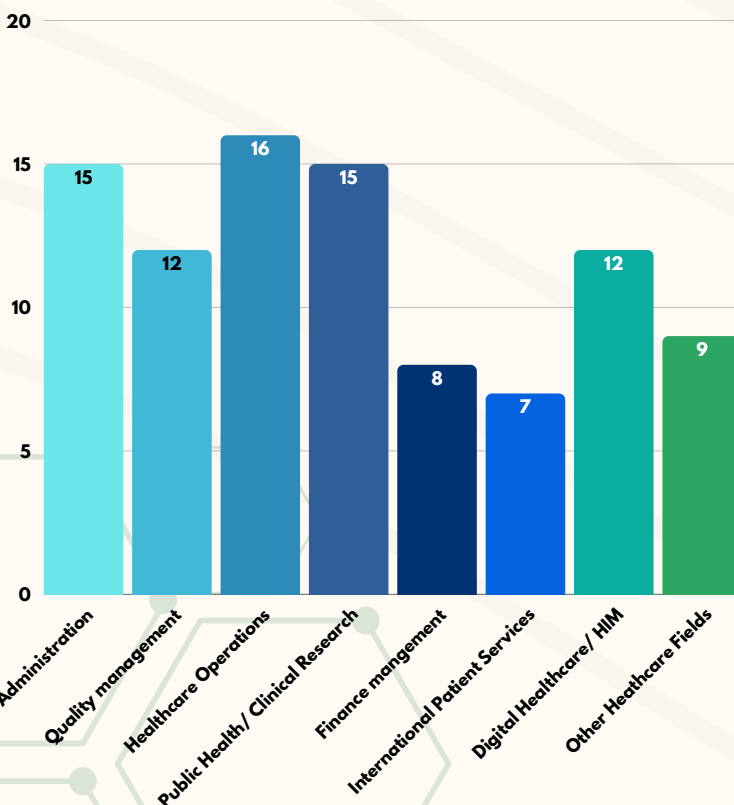

Gender Ratio

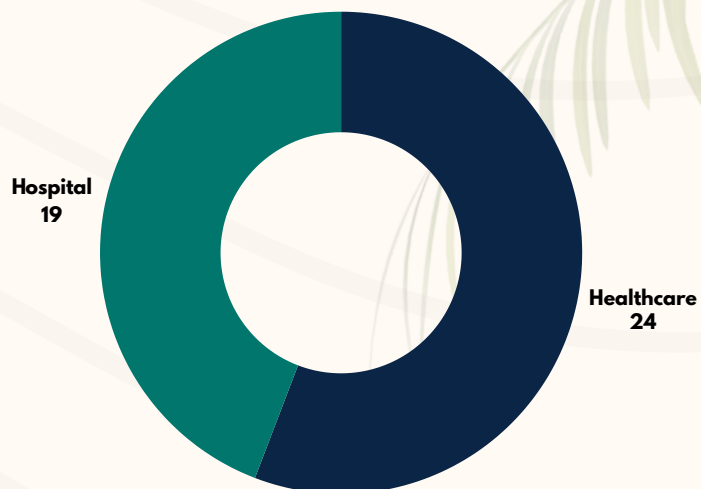

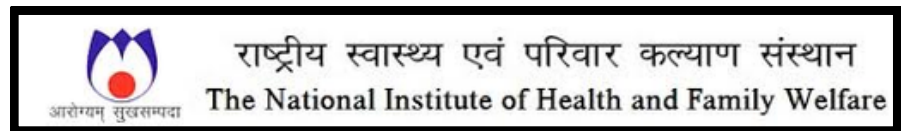
