Multidisciplinary (MD): Students may choose MD courses from a pool of such course offered by Faculty of Humanities & Languages, Social Sciences, Sciences, Management & Fine Arts subject to the prescribed prerequisites and other specific requirements.

***Compulsory for those who seek exit after Second Year (Exit-II). #Only to be earned by those students who have not taken exit either in I or II Year.

If required, a department may add additional courses/credits to the Major or Minor components in consultation with the Dean of Faculty, Timetable In charge & in coordination with COE's office to accommodate requirement of their specific disciplines while not overburdening the students.
