



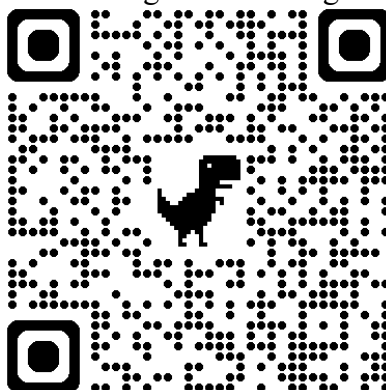

Instructions for Registering on SWAYAM Portal

The students are advised to read the instructions carefully and follow these steps for registration.

1. The SWAYAM portal can be accessed using the following link: <https://swayam.gov.in/>



2. An account needs to be created first on the SWAYAM portal by using the official student email ID provided by the University:

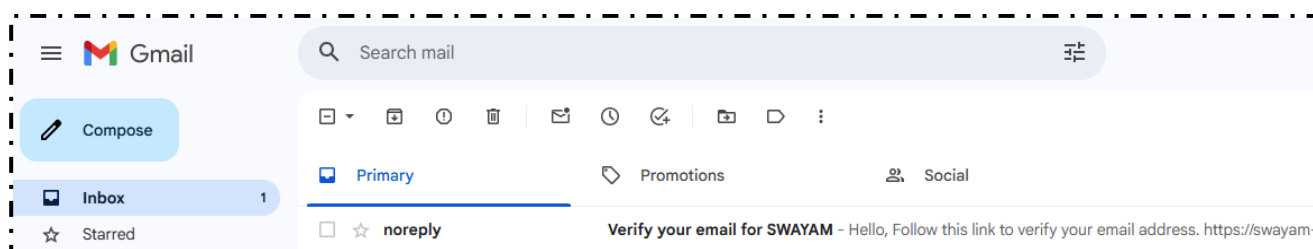

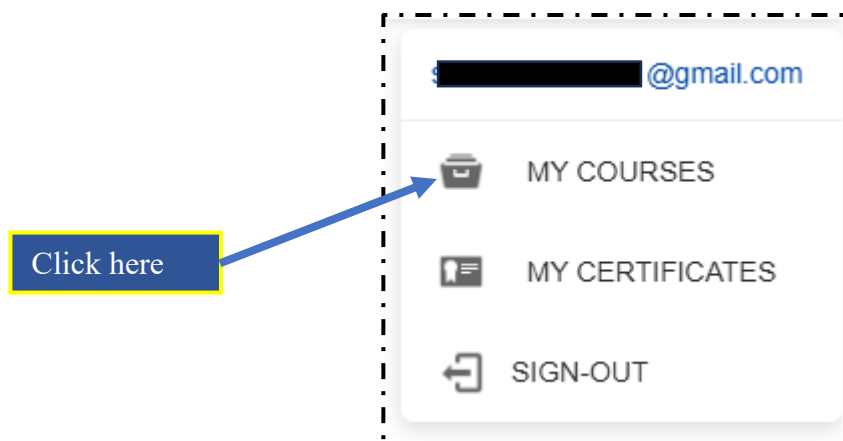
7. Now you can sign in with your new account created on SWAYAM portal.

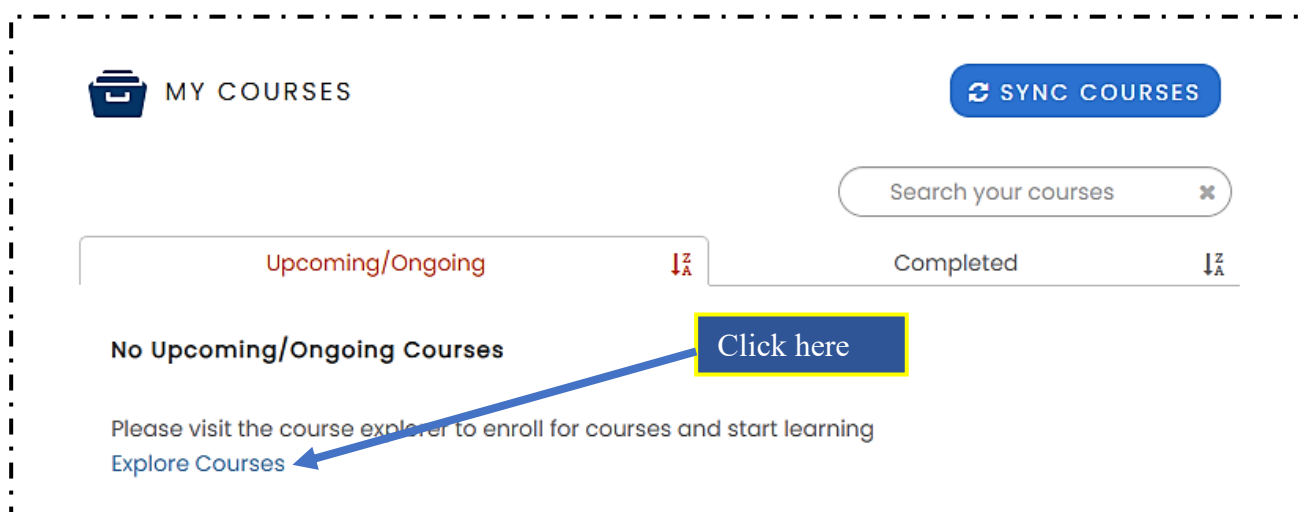
8. After successful login you will get access to the SWAYAM portal:



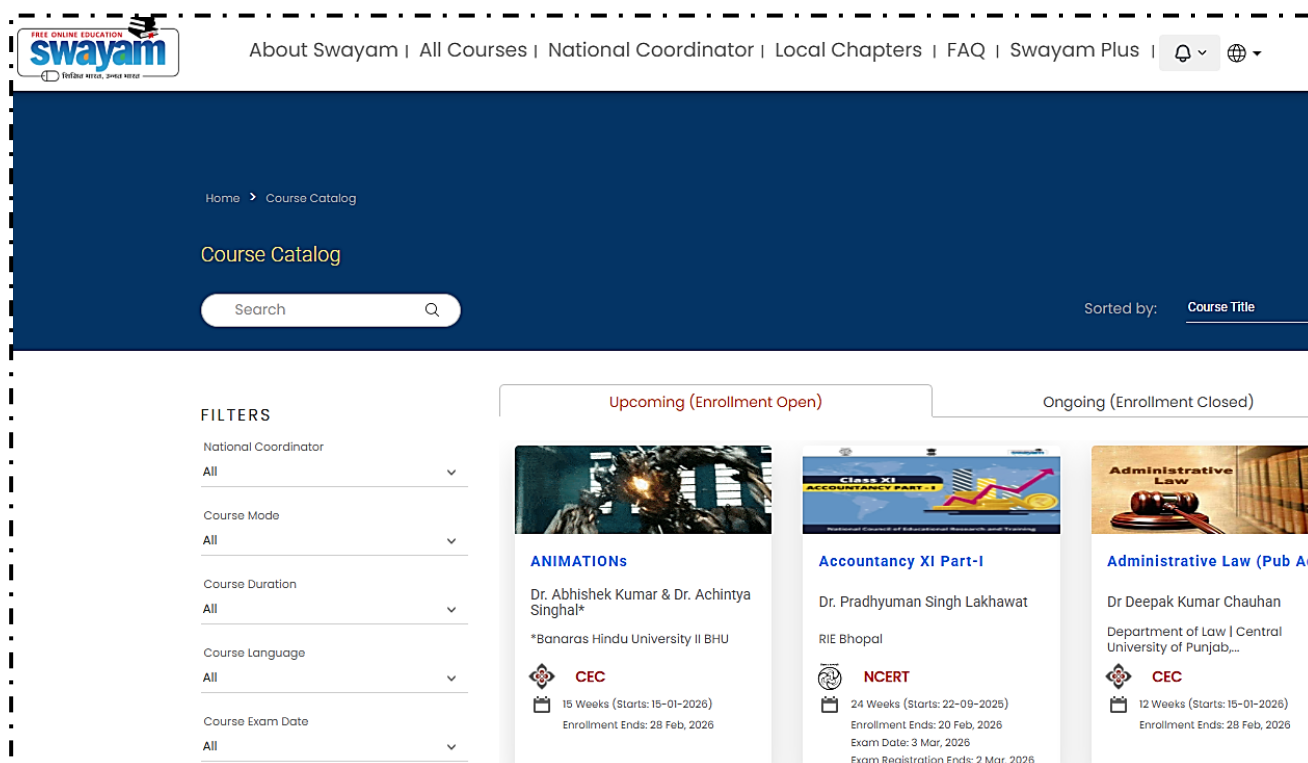
9. You will get the following drop-down menu:

1. Student should attach the copy of SWAYAM Course registration proof.
2. Student should attach the copy of Fee Registration on SWAYAM for end semester exam (if applicable)

16. It is mandatory for all the students to take a minimum of 20% and a maximum of 40% of the courses from SWAYAM in each semester subject to the approval of the BoS/CoS.

17. The students shall be given a choice to select course/s offered by SWAYAM in a semester only from the list duly approved by the BoS/CoS.
18. Every student of a class would be required to register for the SWAYAM course. The students will be responsible for registering on the SWAYAM portal for the course.
19. To pass in a SWAYAM Course, a student must secure a minimum of 40% passing marks separately in assessments - assignments/Quizzes and the end semester examination. The assignments and quizzes component conducted by the SWAYAM shall have a weightage of 30%. The end-term examination shall have a weightage of 70%.
20. It is the responsibility of the student to submit assignments/quiz in time. JMI will not be responsible for non-submission of assignments/quiz on SWAYAM portal.
21. The students who have completed the entire SWAYAM course and submitted a minimum of 75% of the assignments and quizzes on SWAYAM shall only be allowed to appear for the end term examination conducted by the University.
22. If the student prefers to give end semester examination conducted by SWAYAM, then the student shall have to pay the examination fee to SWAYAM. The University will not be responsible for any fee payment.
23. The students who have been debarred from appearing in the end semester examination due to non-fulfilment of above-mentioned criteria shall have to register for the same SWAYAM course in the upcoming semesters. In case the same SWAYAM course is not running in the next semester, the BoS/CoS may approve another SWAYAM course which this student can register.
24. If a student fails in the end semester examination of the SWAYAM course conducted by CoE, JMI, then he/she shall have to appear in the end semester examination in the next academic session as per the examination rules of JMI.
25. The pattern of the end semester examination (subjective or MCQ) shall be decided by the BoS/CoS of the concerned department. The marks for the end semester examination shall be 60% of the total marks of that course.
26. In case of any query the students may contact the Course Facilitator or Departmental Coordinator or Faculty Mentor or University Nodal Officer.
