SOCIETY OF AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERS INDIA:

SAEINDIA is India's leading resource for mobility technology. The ownership of SAEINDIA wrests with its members who are individuals from the mobility community, which includes Engineers Executives from Industry, Government officials, Academics and students. SAEINDIA was first established in Chennai 2002 and became an Affiliate society of SAE International with Dr. K. Kumar as its first President.

SAEINDIA conducts different events over the year focusing on the nurturing and development of student minds along with there technical and managing abilities.

SUPRA SAEINDIA Student Formula is a national level engineering design and fabrication competition organized by the Society of Automotive Engineers India (SAEINDIA) once in a year. The competition takes place in Buddh International Circuit, Noida.The goal of this event is to develop and provide a platform for budding engineers to experience, build and learn. It offers a unique way to test students' theoretical knowledge in a practical context. Students gain and develop skills such as engineering, project management and team work. Points are earned in a series of off track, "Static" events, and on track, "Dynamic" events.

SAE BAJA is an intercollegiate design competition organized by the Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE). It is organized every year worldwide including India, China, Brazil, South Africa and Korea. In India, the event is run by SAE INDIA. Several team of students participates in this competition from all over the world to design and build small off-road cars.The goal of SAE BAJA is to design, build and race off-road vehicles that can withstand the hardest element of rough terrain. The vehicles used in SAE BAJA are often similar in appearance to dune buggies. Before 2007, the event was called "Mini Baja".

EFFICYCLE is an intercollegiate design competition organized by Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) for undergraduate and graduate students where teams participate from across the India and they have to design and fabricate an energy efficient entirely human powered three-wheeled vehicle. The vehicle must be aerodynamically, highly engineered and ergonomically designed. The design should be commercially reliable as a product and should be attractive to consumers because of it's performance, visuality, realibility and ease of performance. SAE INDIA provides an opportunity to engineering students to enhance their practical skills and to built up innovative ideas which can be applied in engineering practices.
