The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and Finance Officer appraised the members about the financial crisis faced by the University having huge recoverable balance more than Rs.100.00 crore due to non/short-receipt of grants from the UGC. Representatives from UGC/MoE were requested to look into the matter and accommodate the University's legitimate requirements including opening recoverable balance under Recurring Salary [OH-36] and Recurring General [OH-31] while considering RBE for the year 2020-21.

It was also requested that the pending grant of Rs.49.00 crore towards arrears of Revised Allowances under 7 CPC, MACP, DACP and CAS may be released urgently.

The Representatives of Ministry of Education assured the Finance Committee that the committed /legitimate expenditure on Salary & Other Component under OH-36, Pension & Non-Salary Item including Property Tax under OH-31 will be considered while conveying RBE 2020-21 in the last quarter.

The Representatives from Ministry of Education also emphasizes that the University may constitute a committee to explore the avenues to enhance the IRG to meet the additional requirements.
