The *Majlis-i-Talimi* (Academic Council) also endorsed the recommendations of the Prospectus Committee to follow a uniform policy at University level for all regular UG, PG programs (Lab and Theory both) in respect of Internal Assessment and University Exam components of the University barring those which are governed by their respective regulatory bodies.

The Ordinance 15-B Clause 4.1 captioned, '**Evaluation**' will be modified accordingly as per the following details:

For All Faculties of the University

For Theory (UG & PG) Courses:

Internal Assessment	40% of allocated marks
Semester End Examination	60% of allocated marks

- The minimum passing mark will be 40% in each component separately. Student failed in IA component will not be allowed to appear in the final exam of this course. The student will have to reappear in the Internal assessment and University exam of that course next year.
- For lab courses where internal assessment has a weightage of 50% and University Examinations has a weightage of 50%, it will remain same.

It was also decided that the duration of theory exams will be of 02 hours instead of the existing 03 hours w.e.f. the next academic session 2025-26. The question papers shall also be prepared accordingly.

The *Majlis-i-Talimi* (Academic Council) also approved the recommendations of the Ordinance Committee for updation in the Ordinance – 5 (V) captioned, '**Admission and Enrollment of Students**', and Ordinance 12 (XII) captioned, '**Admission Committee**' respectively regarding inclusion of the functions of Central Admission Committee and Prospectus Committee as well as the centralized system of the whole admission process in Jamia.

The House authorized the Controller of Examinations to prepare the modified Ordinance – 5 and 12 and submit it to the Ordinance Committee for further course of action.

1. The *Majlis-i-Talimi* (Academic Council) endorsed the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Management of the Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship held on 15.01.2025.

2. It was observed that an amount of 7.5% of the total grant received by Post-Doctoral Fellow is allocated towards contingency which should be utilised by the concerned Department/Centre. The practice is not being followed as the University does not have any Ordinance on Post-Doctoral Fellowship at present.

3. The Dean, Research & Innovation brought to the attention of the House that those students having M.Phil degree and admitted in Jamia in Ph.D. programme are seeking exemption from the Course Work. The concerned Faculty / Department / Centre needs to ascertain whether a candidate has studied this paper in his/her M.Phil. If so, he/she may be exempted from doing the Course Work in their Ph.D programme. It is mandatory to all Ph.D. students to study the course on Research Ethics & Publication of 2 credits, if not studied by the students during M.Phil course work. He clarified that as per University's Ordinance and UGC Regulations, course work having 16 credits is a mandatory requirement for Ph.D. students.

4. Prof. Shahid Tasleem, Head, Department of Foreign Languages has brought to the attention of the House that a number of part-time language programmes of the Department of Foreign Languages have been allotted to CUET. The entrance test

of these programmes conducted by CUET consists of general aptitude test and no test to ascertain the proficiency in the language is conducted by CUET as a result it is very difficult to assess the level of a candidate. Moreover, seats also remain vacant in the courses allotted to CUET. It was decided that the University will conduct its entrance test for the part-time language programmes in case seats remain vacant after the declaration of the CUET result.
