



**MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING**

between

“Fergana State University”

(Republic of Uzbekistan)

and

“Jamia Millia Islamia”

(Republic of India)

« 27.03. » 2026

«Fergana State University», represented by Rector Prof. Dr. Shermukhammadov Bakhodirjon Shermuhammadovich, on the one part, and «Jamia Millia Islamia», represented by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Dr. Mazhar Asif, on the other part (hereinafter jointly referred to as the Parties, and individually as the Party), In view of the partnership and close international relations between the Republic of Uzbekistan and Republic of India. Recognizing the need to develop further bilateral relations between two countries in the educational and scientific areas of cooperation, desiring to make contribution to the development of cooperation between two educational institutions in the abovementioned areas, have entered into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter - Memorandum) on the following conditions.

Article 1

Based on the principles of mutual benefit and respect for independence, the Parties will cooperate in the following areas:

1. Exchange of university staff and teachers;
2. Exchange of bachelor's, master's, doctoral students, scientists, specialists to provide training, research practice and internships;
3. Development and implementation of joint educational programs, including those providing for the issuance of double diplomas, as well as curricula;
4. Organization of academic and working meetings, symposiums, seminars, scientific conferences;
5. Implementation of joint research programs, projects on creation and mastering of technologies;
6. Attracting consultants for master's and doctoral theses and inviting faculty members to carry out research work;
7. Formation of joint scientific teams, laboratories, providing the development of new techniques and technologies;
8. Exchange of scientific and technical information, documentation, literature and bibliographic editions;
9. Information-consulting cooperation on issues of creation (writing) of scientific works, articles and their placement in the International scientific databases;
10. Joint preparation of documents for participation in competitions for national and international funding, as well as in other mutually agreed forms, ensuring the implementation of this Memorandum.

Article 2

The terms and conditions for the implementation of each cooperative program under the Memorandum must be agreed upon and accepted by both Parties through the execution of separate agreements prior to the commencement of each individual program. These separate agreements will clearly describe the functions and activities to be carried out, the work schedule, personal profiles, funding terms and conditions, the rights and obligations of each Party, and the documents necessary to define the objectives and areas of cooperation under each program.

Article 3

It is understood that all activities under this Memorandum have been approved by the appropriate supervisors at each university and are consistent with the scientific and financial requirements of both universities. The results of collaborative research, including but not limited to the intellectual property rights that have arisen, shall be utilized fairly and honestly through consultation between the Parties.

Article 4

In the process of implementation of the provisions of this Memorandum, the Parties shall be guided by the legislation of the country of their registration, as well as undertake to comply with interstate

agreements on cooperation in the field of education, science and culture between the Republic of Uzbekistan and Republic of India.

All types of cooperation specified in Article 1 shall be carried out in accordance with all laws, regulations and normative and legal acts of the country in which these types of cooperation will be carried out.

Article 5

This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of its signing by the authorized representatives of both Parties and be valid for 5 years. If, three months prior to the expiration of its validity period, neither Party or one of the Parties provides written notice regarding amendments, extension, or termination, the Memorandum shall be automatically extended for the next term. The Memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual agreement of the Parties. This Memorandum is drawn up in English in two copies, both having equal legal force.
