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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH

Jamia Millia Islamia, will be herein after referred to as **JMI** and **NuLife** is a medical devices and diagnostic manufacturing company based at Delhi, NCR.

This **MoU** sets down the mutually agreed broad framework for joint research and academic activities in various fields of interest it also incorporates the modalities for collaboration.

1. PREAMBLE:

1.1. **JMI** is a central university under the University Grant commission, Govt of India having extraordinary infrastructure, specialized research activities, teaching and training programs. **JMI** conducts research on a wide range of topics of public health concern. The clinical research and education activities of **JMI** encompass a wide spectrum of basic and translational research domains and are acclaimed internationally.

NuLife is a medical devices and diagnostic manufacturing company. **NuLife** has established itself as a global leader in the progression of in vitro diagnostic lateral flow tests that have revolutionized the market for disease diagnosis and analyte detection. **NuLife** manufacturing and R&D is a state-of-the-art facility currently located in Noida, Uttar Pradesh.

1.2. The activities of **JMI** and **NuLife** are in several ways complementary. These research activities will be fulfilled by jointly working on the areas of interest and utilizing the research facilities of Institute and company. The faculties at **JMI** covering the broader areas in biotechnology, structural biology, nanotechnology, chemical science and physical sciences will be utilized. Facilities at **NuLife** such as Lateral Flow Technology, molecular biology, and ELISA will be desirable. It is therefore felt that initiating collaborative research programmes would be of considerable mutual benefit.

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2. PURPOSE:

JMI and **NuLife** desire to implement, in the areas of mutual interest, cooperative collaborative activities, which would address multidisciplinary scientific, technological and educational problems of relevance to the country. This is facilitated by the instrument of this **MoU** as follows:

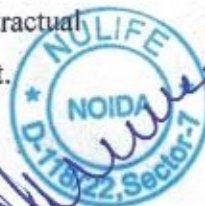
ARTICLE 1

Consistent with the goals and purpose of the collaboration, **JMI** and **NuLife** propose to initiate joint multidisciplinary research. The parties anticipate that the collaborative platform contemplated by this agreement will lead to the development of specific projects, each of which may have academic, clinical and commercial implications. Each specific project proposal will set out in detail the complete responsibilities and commitments of each party for the specific project. The parties acknowledge and agree, however, that this agreement does not obligate them to enter into any further agreement. For each specific project, both parties will obtain concerned Institutional/company Committees clearances from their respective Institution/company and all guidelines with respect to laboratory/animal/clinical studies will be adhered to

Other projects would be taken up to include other areas as mutually agreed upon involving faculty, research scholars, students and technical teams from different departments/ divisions of both the Institute and company.

ARTICLE 2

- a. The faculty and staff of **JMI** and **NuLife** will hold regular meetings on problems of mutual interest.
- b. The faculty and research scholars of **JMI** and **NuLife** will have access to the facilities of both institute and company, subject to their respective rules and regulations.
- c. The faculty and staff of **JMI** and **NuLife** will jointly apply to the funding agencies for financial support for the collaborative research and academic programmes undertaken under this MoU.
- d. The faculty and staff will jointly report progress and accomplishment annually.
- e. For the research project envisaged under this agreement both parties shall seek funding separately or together from external or internal funding agencies. Except as expressly set forth in this agreement, neither party will have any financial or other contractual obligations to the other unless and until they enter into a separate written agreement.



ARTICLE 3

Provision is hereby made for:

- a) The exchange of Faculty, research scholars, staff and students between the two institutes.
- b) The joint organization of Symposia Seminars, Workshops and Lectures, and mutual sharing of data on collaborative projects.
- c) No formal day-to-day permission will be necessary for the faculty, research scholars, staff and students of the two institutes to work in the laboratories of other institute in connection with the research work/ projects approved jointly by the heads of the respective departments of JMI and NuLife.

ARTICLE-4

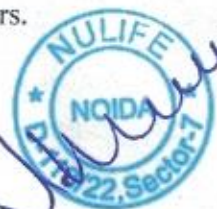
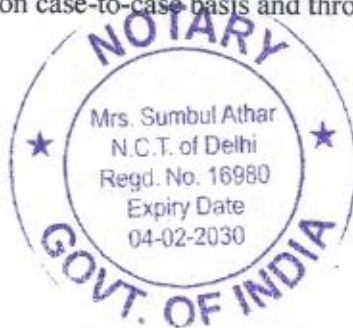
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

- a) Important research findings arising out of the activities covered under this MoU may be published in/presented at national and international Journals/Conferences jointly with the mutual consent of collaborators. The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of the participants on any publication, document and/or paper will require prior permission of both the participants it may however be ensured that the official emblem and logo is not misused.
- b) In case research is carried out solely and separately by the Party or the research results are obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party the Party concerned alone will apply for grant of IPR and once granted the IPR will be solely owned by the concerned Party.
- c) Knowledge developed, which can result in commercial exploitation would be IPR protected and filed jointly by both the institutes. The expenses involved in protecting the PR shall be shared equally. However, if one of the institutes decides not to share the expenses for protecting IPR, then it should assign its rights to the other institute to enable the other institute to file for IPR protection.
- d) Neither party shall reveal intellectual property belonging to the other to any third party without the prior written concurrence of the other party.
- e) Any returns arising of commercialization of the Intellectual Property generated out of the programmes undertaken under this MoU, will be shared in proportion to be decided mutually by both the parties, on case-to-case basis and through exchange of letters.

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- f) Nothing contained herein shall constitute this a partnership or joint venture agreement or constitute either party as the partner principal or agent of the other, this being a MoU between independent contracting entities.
- g) Both parties shall abide by the Government Rules as applicable time-to-time.

ARTICLE-5

NON-EXCLUSIVITY OF THE MoU:

Notwithstanding anything contrary contained in this MoU, the parties either jointly or severally, shall have unrestricted and unconditional right to seek additional funds for and/or to cooperate with any agency/institute for any of the projects covered by the MoU.

Provided nothing herein shall affect the rights and operation of Article 4 of the MoU.

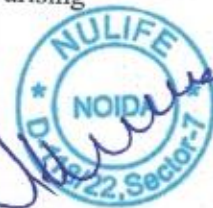
ARTICLE-6

Any article of the MoU may be modified or changed by mutual agreement of the parties hereto in writing. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are modified/extended unless otherwise agreed to.

ARTICLE-7

All disagreement/differences of opinion/disputes regarding the interpretation of the provisions of this MoU shall be resolved by mutual consultation by the signatories. However, in case the dispute persists, the dispute shall be referred to a committee comprising of Vice Chancellor, JMI and Managing Director, NuLife or their nominees and one independent & impartial outside expert referred to by the parties. The decision of the said committee shall be binding and final.

In the event that the dispute is still unresolved after exercising the aforementioned options, the dispute shall be referred to a court of law of competent jurisdiction. The courts in National Capital Territory of Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the disputes arising out of this MoU.



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ARTICLE-8

GOVERNING LAW:

All research activities undertaken jointly by JMI and NuLife under this MoU will be governed by the Laws of the Republic of India.

Termination of MoU: The MoU can be terminated by either of the parties by giving 30 days' notice in writing to the other party.

ARTICLE-9

The tenure of the MoU shall be for three years from the date of signing the MoU, unless opted otherwise by either of the signatory parties to this MoU, the tenure shall be renewed automatically for another three years from the date of expiry of the first tenure.
