



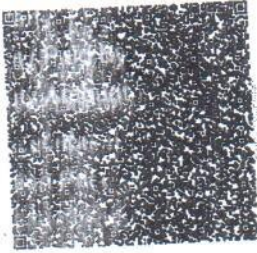

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi

AND

The Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine, New Delhi

1. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 28th day of April 2015 at New Delhi between Jamia Millia Islamia, a statutory Central University, Maulana Mohammad Ali Jauhar Marg, New Delhi-1100025 acting through its Registrar (hereinafter referred to as JMI, party of the **First Part**).

(The expression party of the First Part shall, however, mean and include their successor organizations, appointees, assignees, etc).

AND

The Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine, Jawaharlal Nehru Anusandhan Bhawan, 61-65, Institutional Area, Janakpuri, New Delhi-110058, an autonomous organization under Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India through its Director General (hereinafter referred to as CCRUM, party of the **Second Part**).

(The expression party of the Second part shall, however, mean and include their successor organizations, appointees, assignees etc).

The areas of collaboration between the two organizations will be in the following fields:

1. Literary Research in Unani Medicine
2. Medico-historical Research
3. Collaborative research in areas of mutual interest

These research programmes will be executed by joint collaboration of the CCRUM and JMI through the following departments/centres of JMI

1. Department of History and Culture
2. Department of Arabic
3. Department of Persian
4. Department of English



5. Department of Sociology
6. India-Arab Cultural Centre
7. Centre for West Asian Studies
8. Dr. Zakir Husain Institute of Islamic Studies
9. Dr Zakir Husain Library

2. PREAMBLE

About the Jamia Millia Islamia

Jamia Millia Islamia, an institution originally established at Aligarh, India in 1920 and became a Central University by an enactment of the Indian Parliament in 1988. The Jamia has emerged as an outstanding institution of higher learning with distinct and focused academic programmes. Besides offering education from nursery to class XII and conducting graduate & post graduate courses in nine faculties, the JMI undertakes doctoral programmes in 39 disciplines including Arabic, Persian, Urdu, History, Islamic Studies, West Asian Studies and Sociology etc.

About the CCRUM

Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine is an apex research organization for research and development of Unani Medicine under the ministry of AYUSH, Government of India. The Council was established with a view to aid, develop, conduct and coordinate multifaceted research activities in the field of Unani Medicine including preclinical, clinical, drug standardization, survey & cultivation and literary & historical through a network of 23 research institute/units.



Collaboration Mode

In this present arrangement it is envisaged that Jamia Millia Islamia shall provide space in the University campus for establishing 'Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute for Literary & Historical Research in Unani Medicine' by CCRUM.

The two institutes will also venture for collaborative research studies and even setting up a model institute that will redefine Unani Medicine in the light of Hakim Ajmal Khan's views, the visionary founder of Jamia Millia Islamia.

Responsibilities of Jamia Millia Islamia

- o Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to provide space for establishing Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute for Literary & Historical Research in Unani Medicine. The cost of

developing infrastructure, renovation & furnishing, electricity bills shall be borne by the CCRUM.

- Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to provide academic and technical expertise in research studies to be undertaken by 'Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute for Literary & Historical Research in Unani Medicine' through its departments/centres. The learned faculty members of concerned departments will extend their support in carrying out different research activities. For example; studies on classical literature of Unani Medicine available in Arabic and Persian and socio-cultural context of Unani Medicine etc.
- Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to depute senior faculty members as resource persons in training programmes/brain storming session/workshops to be organized by Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute at regular basis.
- Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to extend facilities for access to central as well as departmental libraries and archives to CCRUM staff for different research objectives.
- Subject to Ordinances, Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to consider council's Research Officers having post graduate degree in Unani Medicine for registration in PhD courses in allied subjects.
- Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to explore possibilities in introducing various course(s) in Unani Medicine.

Responsibilities of CCRUM

- The CCRUM agrees to establish 'Hakim Ajmal Khan Institute for Literary & Historical Research in Unani Medicine' in the campus of Jamia Millia Islamia. The cost of developing infrastructure, renovation & furnishing, electricity/telephone etc. bills shall be borne by the CCRUM.
- The CCRUM agrees to extend support in guiding and training post-graduate students and PhD scholars of the departments/centres; History and Culture, Arabic, Persian, Sociology, West Asian Studies in identifying research problems of common interest and executing them through M.Phil/PhD theses.
- The CCRUM agrees to exchange academic and technical expertise with learned faculty members of concerned departments/centres.
- The CCRUM agrees to extend support in introducing various courses in Unani Medicine at JMI.



- The CCRUM agrees to launch health awareness campaign and organize health camps in the University campus from time to time.

A monitoring committee for this joint collaboration will be constituted by mutual consent of vice chancellor, Jamia Millia Islamia and Director General, CCRUM which will meet periodically and assess the progress of this collaborative process.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of 5 years from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months Notice to the effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the Notice of the intent to terminate the Memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties flowing and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
