About M.A. EP&A Programme

M.A. (Educational Planning & Administration) which was introduced in 1984-85 has planning and administration as its thrust area, programme which was launched in 1997 focuses on the complex needs of elementary education. This is an innovative teacher education programme which presents an effective blend of theory and practice.

In order to improve the quality of all programmes, the entire curriculum is revised/modified at regular intervals or whenever required. Keeping this view, the curriculum of M.A (EP & A) programme of study has been revised. Apart from the four semesters course work devised for the students, an apprenticeship has been incorporated (to be undergone during summer break after second semester course work) into the

programme structure. Recently, the course has been converted into Semester mode.
