JMI declares entrance test results of several university programmes; Entrance exams administered to 1.2 lakh candidates across 9 cities

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) has declared entrance test results of as many as 17 university programmes and released 12 admission lists of selected candidates of its 5 schools, as of today, June 17, 2025. In a massive, monthlong exercise, the university conducted entrance examinations for various courses for the academic year 2025-26 from April 26 to May 30, 2025.
