CGC Organises UDID Registration Camp for Children with Special Needs

New Delhi, September 18, 2026

The Child Guidance Centre (CGC), under the aegis of the Dr. Zakir Husain Memorial Welfare Society, Jamia Millia Islamia, organised a UDID (Unique Disability ID) Registration Camp on September 15, 2026, to facilitate children with special needs who had not yet obtained their UDID cards.

More than 50 parents of children with disabilities benefited from the camp, receiving assistance with the UDID registration process and information about the importance and benefits of the card. Parents were also provided guidance regarding documentation and various government schemes and services available to eligible persons with disabilities.

Prof. Mohammad Ghazi Shahnawaz, General Secretary, Dr. Zakir Husain Memorial Welfare Society, interacted with parents and emphasised the importance of ensuring that every eligible child with special needs obtains a UDID card to facilitate access to appropriate facilities and support.

Dr. Mohd. Faijullah Khan, Secretary, Dr. Zakir Husain Memorial Welfare Society, highlighted that the UDID card and disability certification are important for eligible persons with disabilities to access applicable government schemes, educational support, transport concessions, disability pension and other welfare measures. He also noted that disability documentation is relevant for eligible candidates seeking applicable reservation benefits in higher education and government employment, subject to prescribed eligibility criteria and rules.

The camp also included multidisciplinary assessment and support for the children. Special Educators, Psychologist, Speech Therapist and Occupational Therapist of the Child Guidance Centre assessed and supported the students according to their individual needs.

The initiative reflects the vision of Prof. Mazhar Asif, Vice Chancellor, Jamia Millia Islamia and President, Dr. Zakir Husain Memorial Welfare Society, and Prof. Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, Registrar, Jamia Millia Islamia and Vice President, Dr. Zakir Husain Memorial Welfare Society, towards strengthening inclusive support systems and improving access

to services for children with special needs. The camp reaffirmed the commitment of the Child Guidance Centre and the Dr. Zakir Husain Memorial Welfare Society towards inclusion, empowerment and holistic development of children with special needs and their families.
