This camp is an integral part of department's co-curricular activities that will last till 23rd December 2025. The first day of the camp commenced with the attendance of all students, followed by a power-packed yoga session conducted by Dr. Arif Mohammad, Assistant Professor, DTT & NFE, JMI setting an energetic and positive tone for the programme.

The inauguration programme began with the recitation of the Holy Quran by marking an auspicious start to the event. Adding to the spirit of the occasion, Tarana Team led by Mr. Zeeshan Zamir Ahmed, Instructor, DTT & NFE, JMI melodiously sang the Jamia Tarana and NSS song infusing enthusiasm and pride among the participants.

and highlighted the role of a true educator in shaping empathetic and ethical individuals.

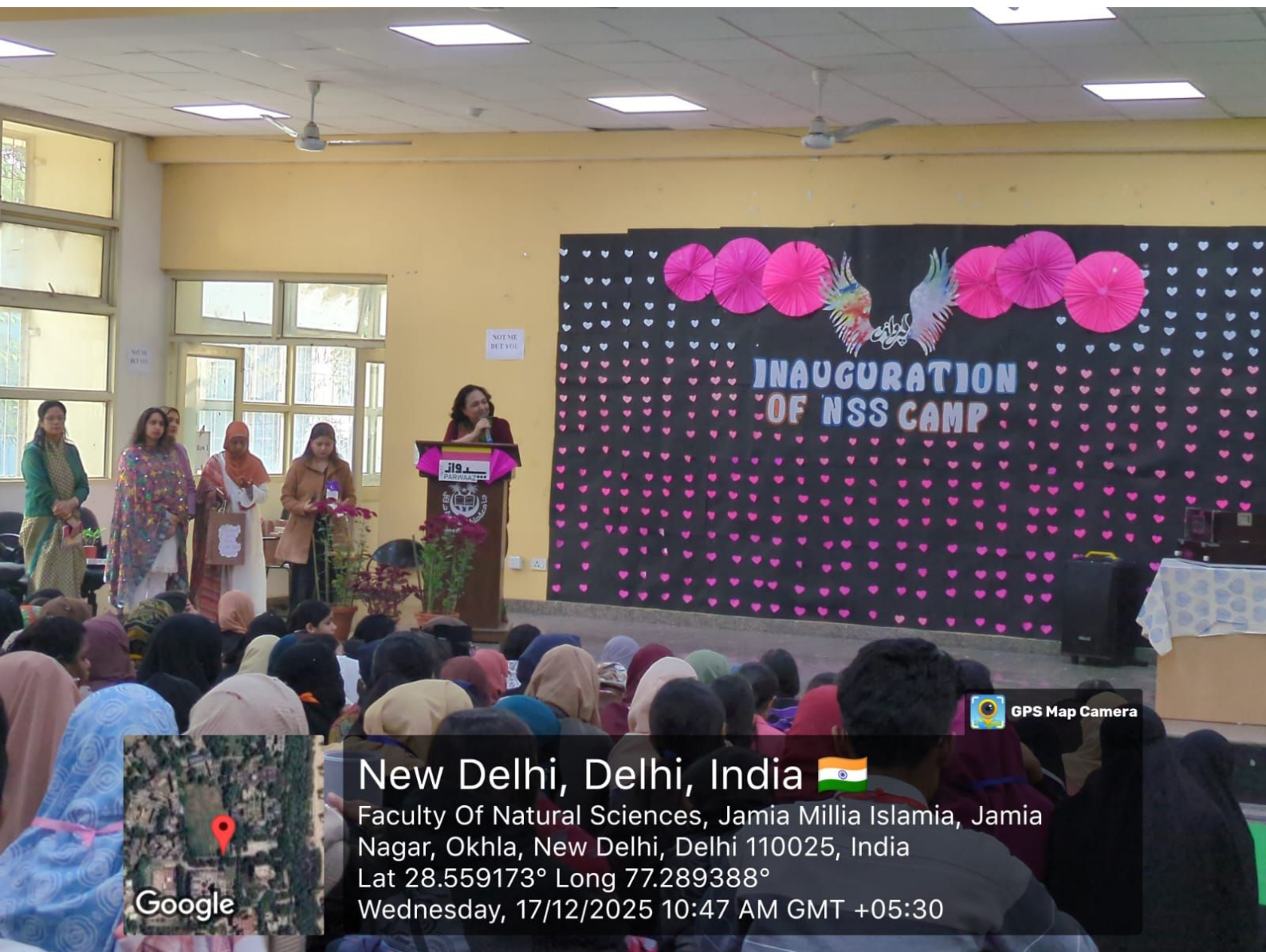
