**University Placement Cell, JMI Organizes Two-Day Employability Enhancement Workshop on 'Acing Case Interviews and Storytelling for Jobs in Consulting'**

The University Placement Cell (UPC), Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI), successfully concluded a high-impact, two-day Employability Enhancement workshop titled, "**Acing Case Interviews & Storytelling for Jobs in Consulting**", from January 29th to 30th.
