Jamia Millia Islamia launches the Prospectus for the Academic Session 2026–27; Online Admissions Open today; 30 new programs added with no fee hike for any courses; Admissions under the Multiple Entry Mode for Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUP) commence from this session

New Delhi, February 20, 2026

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) today released its Prospectus for the academic session 2026–27, outlining comprehensive guidelines for admissions across undergraduate, postgraduate, advanced diploma, PG Diploma, Certificate and Diploma programs. The 150-page prospectus, which was launched today by the Vice Chancellor, JMI, Prof. Mazhar Asif, and Registrar JMI, Prof. Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, along with the Controller of Examinations (CoE), Prof. Ahteshamul Haque and other university officials, provides detailed information on eligibility criteria, application links, entrance examinations, admit cards, syllabi, test centers, course fee structures, and tentative timelines for the declaration of results.

CoE, Prof. Haque briefed that JMI has introduced 30 new programs for the upcoming academic session, marking a significant expansion of its academic offerings. These are: B.A. (Hons) Japanese Studies (Self Financed); B.A. (Hons) German Studies (Self Financed); B.A. (Hons) Uzbek Language, Literature & Culture; B.A. (Hons) Human Resource Management, (Self Financed); Advanced Diploma in Child Guidance and Counselling (Self-Financed) (RCI Approved Program); M.Sc. (Biosciences) As per NEP ; M.Sc. (Biotechnology) as per NEP; M.Sc (Botany) as per NEP; MA (Social Work) as per NEP; MA (HRM) As per NEP; MA (Sociology) as per NEP; ITEP B.Sc B.Ed (Secondary); ITEP B.A B.Ed (Secondary); M.Sc. (Renewable Energy) (Self Financed); B.Tech. (Robotics & Artificial Intelligence) (Self Financed); B.Tech. Civil Engineering (Construction Technology) (Self Financed); B.E. (Civil Engineering) Evening, (Self Financed); B.E. (Electrical Engineering) Evening, (Self Financed); B.E. Significantly, there has been no increase in course fees across all programs for 2026–27. In line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, admissions under the Multiple Entry Mode for Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUP) will commence from the academic session 2026–27, offering enhanced flexibility to students. To improve accessibility for candidates across the country, JMI has expanded its network of entrance test centres to cover the entire country. Therefore, three new entrance test centres, that is, Jaipur, Dehradun, and Kishanganj, have been added, taking the total number of test centres to 11. Existing test centres include Delhi, Lucknow, Guwahati, Patna, Kolkata, Srinagar, Calicut, and Bhopal.

Congratulating the Prospectus Committee and the Controller of Examinations on the timely release of the prospectus, VC JMI, Prof. Asif stated, "This year, we have introduced 30 new programs, carefully designed in alignment with the NEP 2020 guidelines, and also started admissions under FYUP. JMI is especially pleased to have not increased any fee for its courses, which is significant. We have increased test centres to 11 this year so as to ensure that students from all regions of India study at JMI."

Prof. Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, Registrar, Jamia Millia Islamia, lauded the committee members for their dedicated efforts and painstaking deliberations over the past few months that went into putting together the university's prospectus. Prof. Rizvi said, "This year's academic offerings reflect JMI's unwavering commitment to academic rigour, inventiveness, and responsiveness to the emerging educational milieu at national and international levels. We hope to expand academic opportunities for students and make JMI a model for other universities to follow."

Prof. Haque said that the office of the CoE is committed to conducting a fair and transparent admission and examination process as per JMI admission policies.

Aligning with the Government of India's agenda for internationalization of higher education and to increase the intake of foreign students in Indian universities, JMI has substantially reduced fees for foreign students under the General and Supernumerary seats categories. A region-wise differential fee structure has been introduced for students from SAARC countries, West Asian countries, and African & Latin American countries across eligible UG, PG, and diploma programs.

To simplify the online application process, admissions for 2026–27 have been organized under four distinct categories, each with a dedicated application link: These are:

Online forms for the programs for which the university will conduct entrance tests will be available from today until March 25, 2026. Online forms for programs whose admissions will be done on the merit of JEE Mains, NATA, NEET for BPT, NCET and CUET will also be available from February 20, 2026, until 10 days after the declaration of results by the respective test agencies. Online admission forms for programs under Multiple Entry mode—for FYUP programs where seats are vacant—will be available from February 20, 2026, to April 10, 2026.
