On the occasion of the Annual Function of Jamia Senior Secondary School held yesterday at Jamia Millia Islamia's (JMI) Dr. M.A. Ansari Auditorium, Dr. Sukanta Majumdar, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Education, in a video message congratulated the university and school administration for adapting the NEP 2020 in letter and in spirit. 


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
