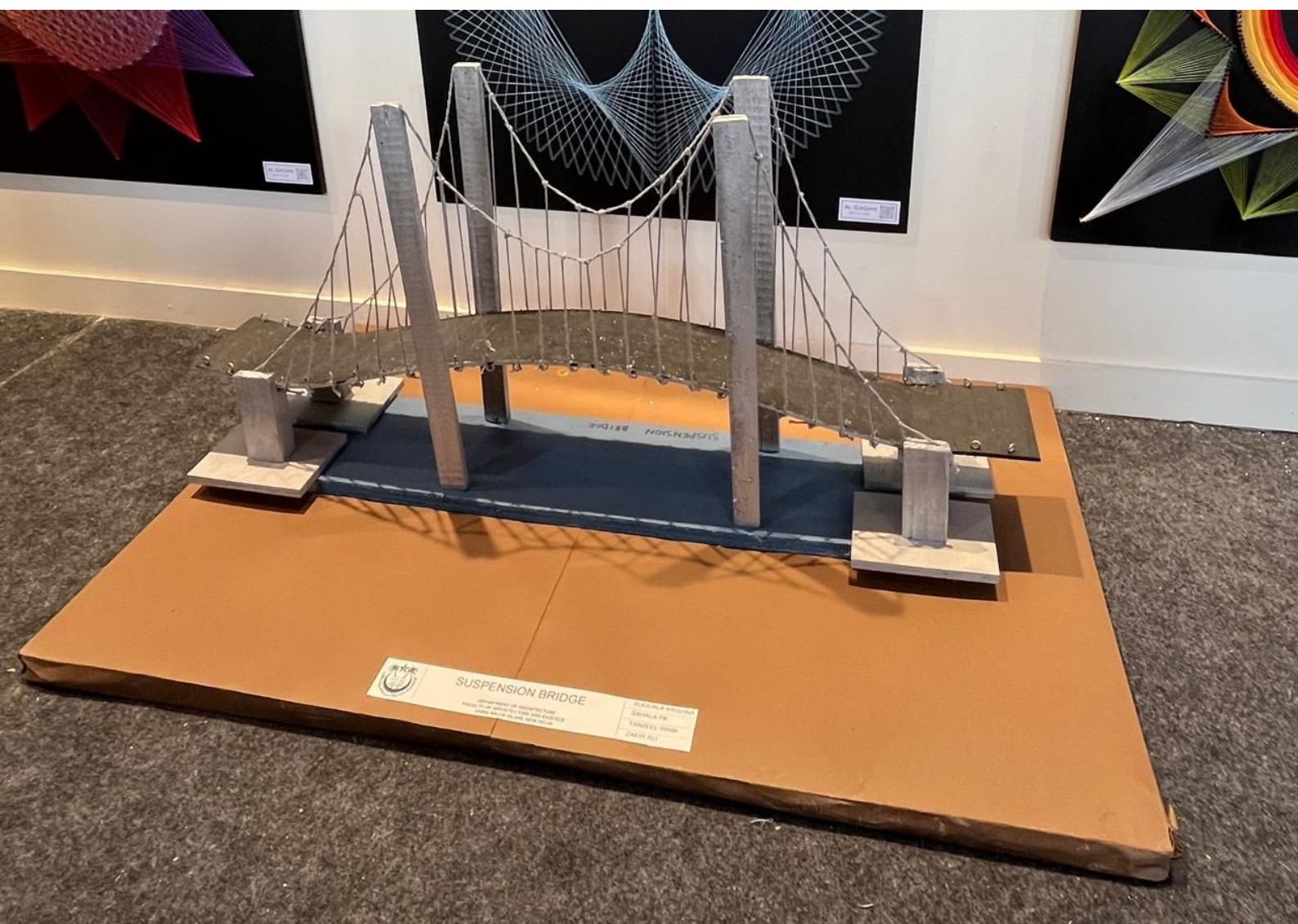
The theme of the work aligns with India's rich architectural heritage and underscores the vital role of architecture in shaping the nation's cultural identity, built environment, and sustainable future.
