Faculty of Dentistry, JMI, organizes a workshop on 'Reflective Narratives For Ethical Dental Practice' for interns and externs of the BDS Batch of 2021

Faculty of Dentistry, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) yesterday organized a workshop on 'Reflective Narratives for Ethical Dental Practice' which was attended by 50 interns and externs, BDS batch of 2021.

The programme commenced with the Coordinator, Dr. Ashu Bharadwaj, Professor Periodontology, Faculty of Dentistry, welcoming the gathering and emphasizing on the role of reflective narratives as a means of ethical dental practice. Highlighting on humanistic competencies through a poetry, participants were made aware about critical reflexivity, visual literacy, advocacy, and cultural and structural humility. She also used images to invoke suppressed feelings of empathy, anger, trauma, and justice for patients. Participants were encouraged to share their stories and come forth with creative content.

The interns and externs actively participated in the experiential activities with dynamic inputs from the resource person and coordinator, Dr. Ashu Bharadwaj.

Prof. Anuradha Sharma, Coordinator, felicitated the resource person. She was joined by the organizing committee members.
